Someone "up there" is reading Travelchat! A gentleman from Canada Customs called to put us straight about duty-free allowances for travellers - and to tell us about a loophole that

all vacationers can appreciate. Under the short-stay, \$10 only allowance, you

cannot bring back tobacco or alcohol, only knickknacks. Under the quarterly \$50 allowance you can

bring back cigarettes and a bottle, but the Canada Customs men are watching for those who might abuse this verbal declaration. Frequent travellers might find themselves subject to scrutiny if the officer is suspicious or happened to clear them through with a \$50 verbal declaration a month before.

However, said our informant, when you go away and declare your full \$150 annual allowance, you're wiser to mail your gifts than carry them with you. You can send as many parcels up to a \$15 value as you wish, but if they come with your luggage you are subject to duty if they go over the allowance.
