It is a radiology prodecure that resembles x-rays in some ways, but it's better.

The patient is injected with a saline solution that contains a radioactive substance, usually Technetium, and this is combined with different chemical compounds to enable it to localize in different organs of the body. What happens once this radioactive substance reaches its goal is simply this. If a disease is present in an organ, it will cause the distribution of the radioactivity to be altered and hence a diagnosis can be made.

BORROWED HELP At present, York Central Hospital does not have a full time Nuclear Medicine Technologist on the staff, but Brenda Glendenning of York County Hospital in Newmarket is performing the duties on a part-time basis.


