Rethink values

A physician lay dying at the early age of 41. A rural doctor, he was returning from an after midnight call when he fell asleep, and his car — out of control — smashed into a row of trees. We were gathered in the waiting room, not far from the operating room where his fellow surgeons were working frantically to save his life — even though it seemed in vain. The gathering consisted of his wife, mother, sister, twin brother and myself. They were tense moments for all of us, as we

faced the hard facts of life.

In the quietness of it all his twin brother, Bert, spoke softly, slowly and solemnly, saying, half to himself and half to us all, "This is where I have to re-think my values in life".

1979 has been ushered in amidst many sobering experiences. Marriages are breaking up in violence and sometimes even in murder; muggings are becoming all too commonplace; morals are confused for multitudes, even of so-called "good folk"; and ethics seem to have gone down the drain for much of business. Right and wrong are so intertwined

that law, order and justice find it difficult to distinguish one from the other.

The shock of all this has brought many, as Bert, to re-think their values in life. A number are tending to return to the traditional churches with a sounder faith. But have we as a people realized the seriousness of our situation? Does it call for a deeper dedication to the principles of life as laid down by Jesus Christ than we are, as yet, ready to give?

Amos N. Wilder, some time ago said that our present crisis takes us from the

traditional poetry of Masfield, Noyes, Tennyson, and Emerson to that of Hawthorne and his symbol of evil; to

John Donne, and to John Bunyan to find our answers. This is no time for the wishful thinking of false prophets, but a time to seek out Amos, Hosea, Isaiah and Jeremiah, who speak to us of the underlying meaning and order of the actual world — not mere fancies.

This new year of 1979 affords us an opportunity to re-think our values of Christ-centred people, soundness will be well as socially. This must be NOW — far-reaching and inner effect of our

thinking in the realm of morals and ethics.

It is here — and not in economic matters, important as they are — that we rise or fall. It is the moral-ethical life style that controls economics; for all business, in the final analysis, depends on trust and faith built on a sound basis of life. If our run-away underlying meaning and order of the actual world — not mere fancies. we must begin by re-thinking our life style. When we become a God fearing, Christ-centred people, soundness will be well as socially. This must be NOW — far-reaching and inner effect of our as time is running out.
