## Writer will autograph new book

Dean Hughes, a Unionville resident, will make two public appearances in March to sign copies of his new book "And So They Bought A Farm".

This Saturday, March 3, he will be at the Green Gables Book Store, 40 Main Street North, Markham, from 12:30 to 2 p.m., and on March 17, he'll appear at Lord's Books, Main Street, Stouffville, from noon to 2 p.m.

Mr. Hughes, who has lived at Briarwood Farm in Unionville since 1945, started out at Maclean's as an editor and then worked in England for a newspaper and publishing company.

He then moved on to interviewing celebrities for the London Express and even managed to get into the night-club entertainment business for awhile.

Back in Toronto, he started doing radio commercials for CFRB and the Associated Broadcasting Company.

He did some on-air work at CKCL (how CKEY) and in 1939 started writing for the CBC.

He has done both radio and TV work for the CBC but his most famous series "The Craigs" was a 10-minute radio drama which ran for more than 25 years.

His previous publications include ARGOSIES in Dawn (poetry) Chapbook; Ryerson Press, 1928; and Along The Sideroad: 1973-4; Nelson, Foster and Scott.

He is one of Canada's most prolific writers of radio and television dramas and documentaries. His latest book is based on actual experiences in his own life.
