Spain is steeped in history

GRANADA, Spain -The date 1492 is significant in Spanish history for more than one reason.

Not only does it represent the beginning of a Spanish presence in the New World, but coincidentally, it was in 1492 that a flourishing Moslem society was driven from Spanish soil.

And while it is nearly five centuries since the Moors were conquered, southern Spain is still graced with many arabesque remnants, including the celebrated Alhambra.

This magnificent 13th century fortress, which overlooks the southeastern Spanish city of Granada, is one of the most popular attractions in the entire Iberian peninsula.

Now part of a 35-acre park, this majestic vestige of the Moorish civilization continues to intrigue visitors, as it has through the centuries visitors such as the Duke of Wellington and writer Washington Irving (who wrote Tales of the Alhambra).

Nestled on a hilly terrace, with the snowcapped Sierra Nevada mountains as a backdrop, the Alhambra's 13 towers command a panoramic view of the city below and of the golden plains to the

Inside its formidable walls, the Alhambra is comprised of a palace, a castle, and an assortment of intriguing rooms and


