## Toronto Bishop will visit here

Local residents as well as church and community leaders will have the opportunity next week to hear the Bishop of Toronto, the Right Reverend Lewis S. Garnsworthy, speak and to converse with him on subjects they wish to examine.

Bishop Garnsworthy's itinerary includes services at three churches in the area.

April 22 he will be at St. Steven's Church in Maple at 8 a.m., 11 a.m. at Christ Church in Woodbridge and at 7:30 p.m. a special service for young people at Holy Trinity in Thornhill.

Rev. Garnsworthy will be interviewed at Classcomm, Cable 10 in Richmond Hill at 2:30 p.m., April 22.

Rev. Robert Grisdale, rector of Holy Trinity in Thornhill will be conducting the TV interview to be shown live, and he said he will discuss the growth of the church in our area as well as general issues that will affect the church.

From the local cable station interview, the bishop will go to a "Deanery Dialogue" at St. John's Anglican Church on Yonge Street below Stouffville

Sideroad. This meeting will be moderated by Rev. Ron Armstrong from Emmanuel Church in Richvale and the minister of St. John's, Rev. Aaron Zull.

Rev. Zull said members of congregations in the area will have the opportunity at this meeting to discuss issues currently before the church or any matter they wish to question the bishop about.

April 23, Toronto's Anglican Bishop will attend a "pot luck" luncheon at St. Mary's Anglican Church in Richmond Hill where he will speak with special emphasis for senior citizens of the area. This luncheon will be followed by a Eucharist.

At 7:30 on Monday April 23, an open meeting for clergy, active laypeople in area parishes, and regional council will be held at St. Gabriel's on Bayview Avenue in Richmond Hill.

The Bishop has indicated that he "looks forward to a creative, purposeful visit with the clergy and laity, and to spending extra time in this important and dynamic area of the diocese".

## Y launches new programs

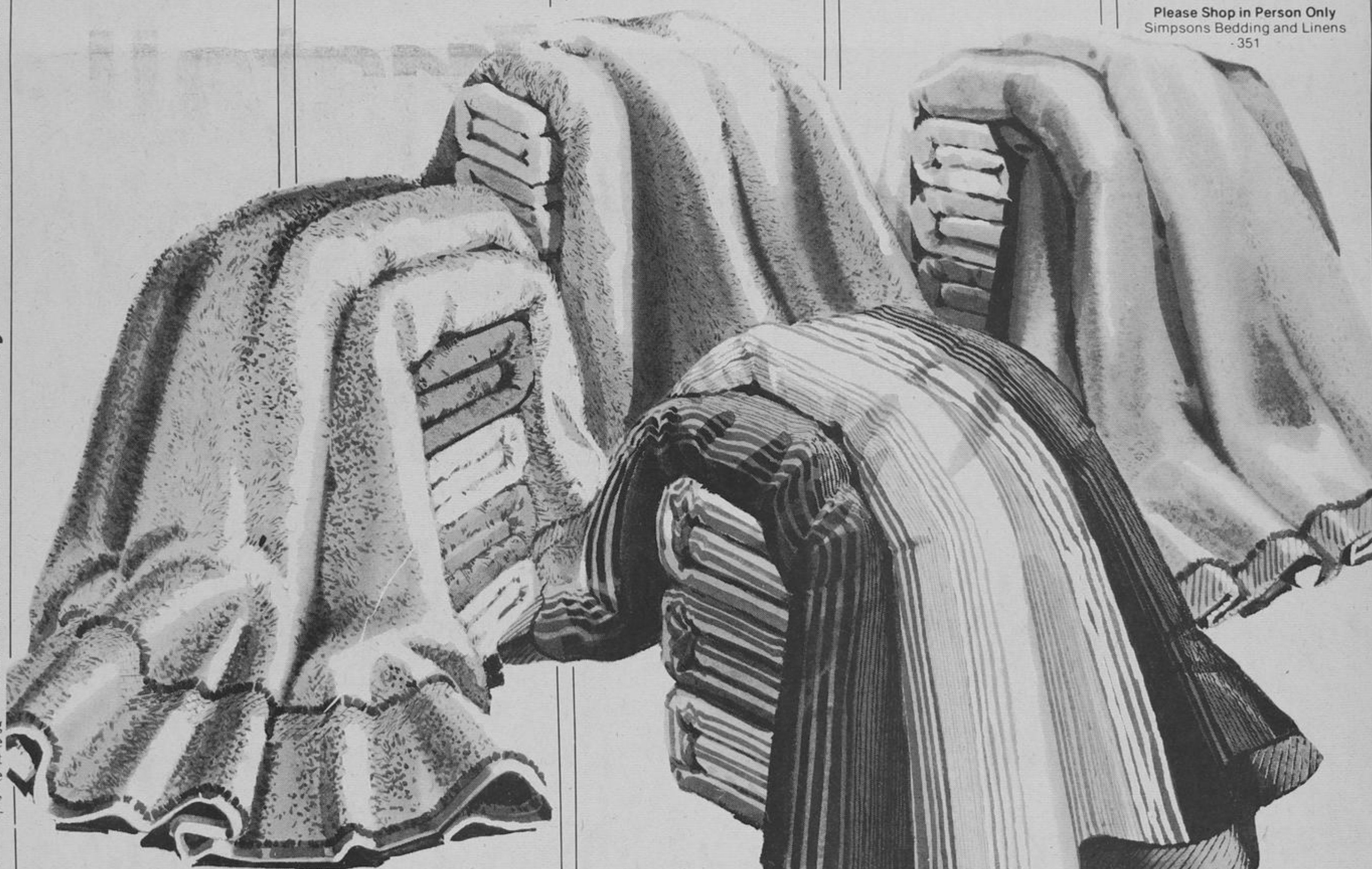

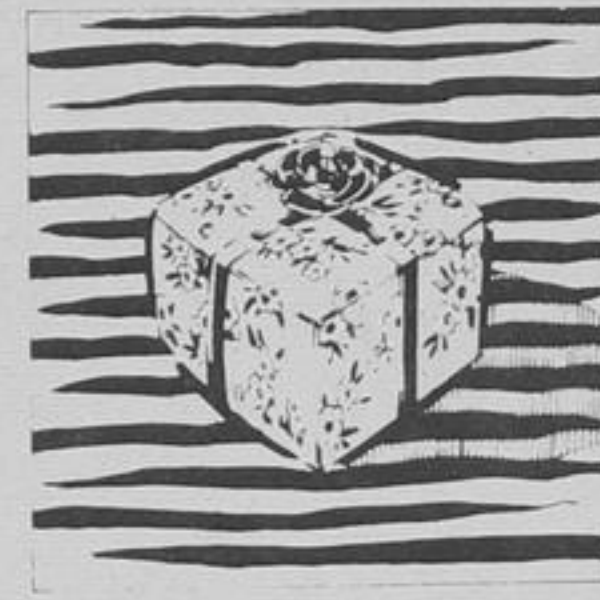
