

Police Briefs

SKI SPECIAL IN MARKHAM

On January 27 an 18-year-old man stole a pair of skis from a car belonging to Paul Harcourt of George Street in Markham. On February 8 the same man and a friend took three pairs of skis from the garage of James Thomson of Hamilton Hall Drive in Markham, and on their way home they also stole skis from a residence on Frederickton Drive.

On January 25, the first assault took a pair of skis from the garage of Tom Carmichael of Church Street in Markham.

On March 2 the same two men stole a tool box from a car parked on Wooten Way near Highway 7.

On April 2, some of the property was found at the home of the 18-year-old and the rest of it was located at his friends' homes, to whom he had sold it. A Keystone movie camera was also found, to which the man admitted stealing.

He was arrested on April 2 for four counts of theft over \$200, two of theft under and possession, at 12:30 p.m. and taken to 28 Division then released for a court appearance on April 17. The second man, a 17-year-old resident of Markham, was arrested for two counts of theft over \$200 and one of theft under, the same day at Markham District High School and released for court on April 17.

TOOLS, AIR CONDITIONER GONE

Between April 2 at 7:30 p.m. and April 3 at 9 a.m. the K&N Garage on Langstaff Road in Thornhill was entered by breaking a bay window and opening the door from the outside.

A tool box containing various "Snap-On" tools and an air conditioning unit all worth \$10,000 were stolen.

As a result, two Toronto men were arrested for break, enter and theft and possession over \$200 on April 4, one Downsview man was arrested on the same charges and a warrant is out for a fourth man on similar charges plus one of escaping lawful custody.

HONEY POT LOSSES

On March 14 at 3 p.m. a man entered Borovoy Auto Supplies on Yonge Street in Richmond Hill with a list of supplies which he stated were for the Honey Pot Ski Lodge in Maple. The order was filled and he signed the bill.

On March 16 at 4 p.m. a second man went to the same outlet and did the same thing. Altogether, they obtained \$335-worth of tools. The Honey Pot received the bill and reported the incidents to police.

The first suspect is described as: 1) male, white, 5'6" tall, 19-20-years-old, having medium-length black hair and wearing coveralls. There is no description of the second man.

AN EXTINGUISHER AND HATCHET MAN

Between April 3 at 7:30 p.m. and April 4 at 6:30 p.m. 20 fire extinguishers and 20 axes were stolen from 20 buses belonging to Atlantic Bus Lines Limited of Markham. The vehicles were parked on the company's Bullock Drive premises at the time.

TWO'S COMPANY, THREE'S A CROWD

On April 7 at 12 midnight, William John Doyle of Locust Hill in Markham was in the process of leaving the McDonald's restaurant at Birchmount and Finch Avenue East in the company of three females. At that point, a carload of youths tried to cut him off the road. Later, two other carloads of youths tried to cut Mr. Doyle off.

At 68 Oaklee Circle in Markham, he was attacked by eight men who struck him over the head with a wooden club. The suspects range in age from 15-17. The suspect vehicles are described as an old Ford Fairlane (maroon), a Dodge Dart (red with a green hood) and a green Dart with mag wheels.

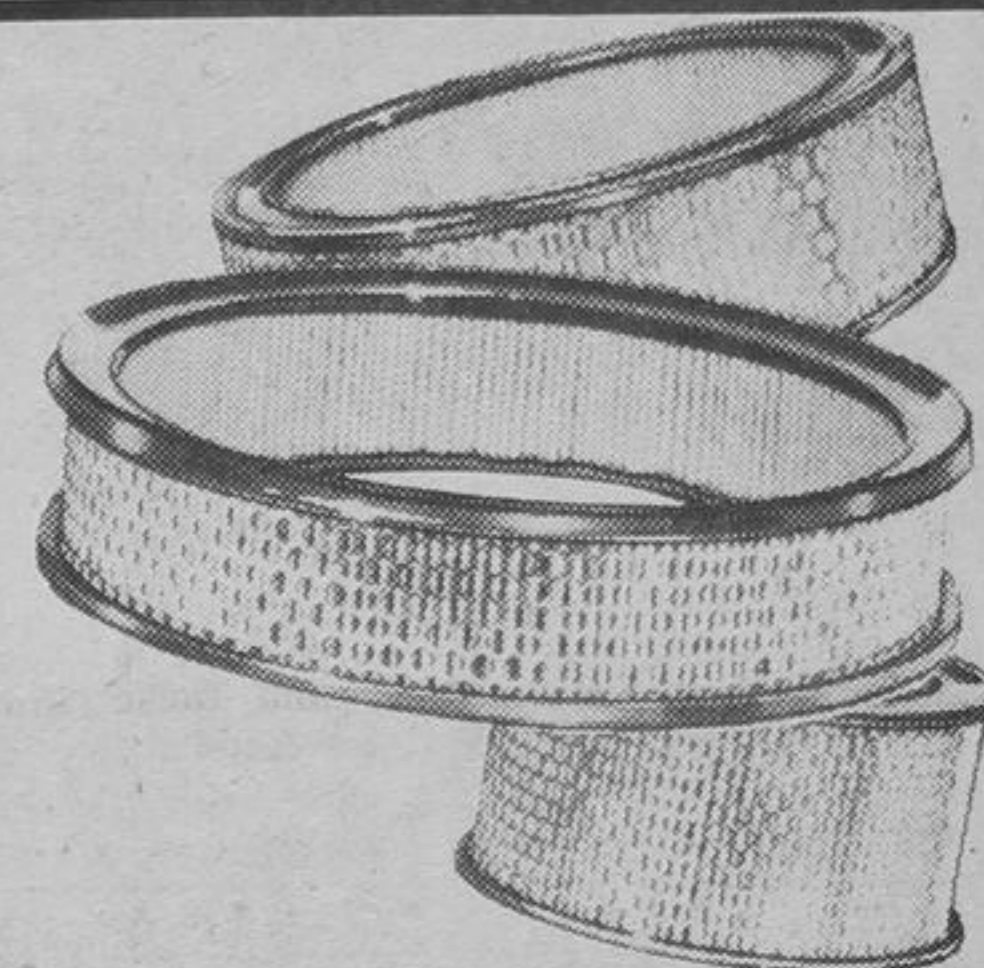

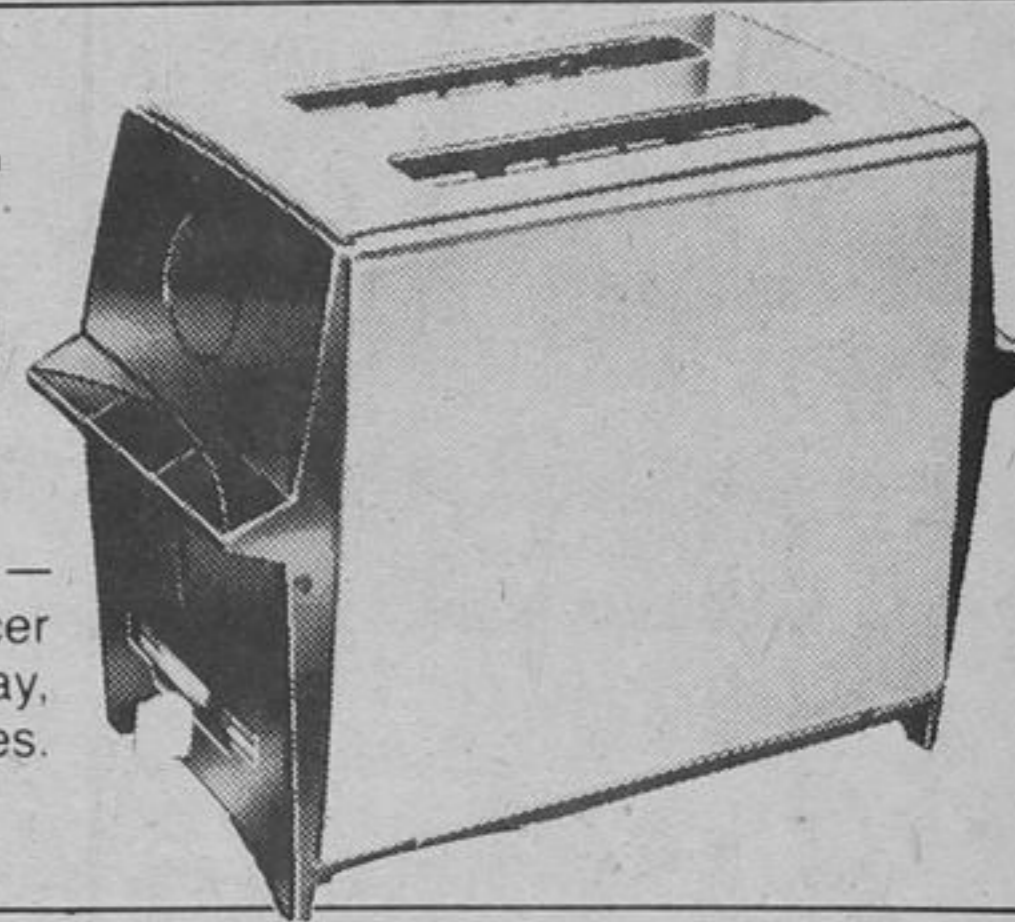
