Poach eggs only.... were sent to study the game and fish laws in a small six by eight cell. Today the 213 conservation officers in Ontario help many of us, at least they keep us on the right track. Being Law Officers under the Criminal Code of Canada, C.O.'s have the same power as all other police officers, municipal,

provincial and RCMP. Having no contact with these officers, many of us have no idea how poaching affects us, the law-abiding sportsmen. T. Matz, a conservation officer covering the Manitoulin Island area, estimated that between 500 and 900 deer were illegally taken on the island during the year of 1977 alone. Estimating the numbers for all of Ontario, the figures are mind-boggling, as is the cost of policing.

INCONSISTENCY In many instances, hunting privileges are revoked for a year or so, but this is inconsistent as some judges take the license away and some don't. Perhaps it will occur to the justice department that violators should lose their privilege to hunt forever if they are repeaters. The same holds true for anglers and I predict that next year we will have a residents angling permit which
