

Officially, it's "Beaver Creek Industrial Park"

Richmond Hill now has a name for its proposed industrial park.

Last Monday night council agreed with the Finance Committee recommendation to name the industrial site the "Town of Richmond Hill Beaver Creek Industrial Park".

The Official Plan of the town designates the 700 acres, bounded by Highway 7, 16th Ave. Highway 404 and a point just west of Leslie Street, as industrial land.

At a Finance Committee meeting Com-

missioner of Finance, Bill Rice, brought up the question of designating an identifiable name for the property.

"South-East Industrial Park" and "Leslie Street Industrial Park" had been used, but Mr. Rice felt neither was distinc-

tive and the latter was an identification which could be confused with Metro Toronto.

names was distinctive for marketing purposes. The remaining local landmark is the "Beaver Creek" which cuts through the easterly portion of the area and will form the largest dry pond storm retention area. That factor decided the name.

It costs to own a dog

Amendments to the Animal Control and Dog Licensing bylaws in Richmond Hill are going to make quite a difference to pet owners.

On May 1 the license fee was increased from \$5 to \$8 for a spayed or neutered dog, from \$12 to \$15 per year for a male or female dog and for the third and each additional dog the rate went from \$15 to \$20 per year.

Richmond Hill Clerk Dave Weldon said the rates have been increased to partially reflect the added cost involved in service provided to the residents.

Mr. Weldon said the increased charge for the third and each additional dog, was to discourage home owners from having too many dogs.

Two new features included in the bylaw are reductions of \$1 for producing a valid rabies certificate and a reduction for senior

citizens, to be charged only \$4 per year.

The new bylaw will help animal control officer, Jim Ryan, in his job by adding a clear definition of when a dog is running at large, as well as giving an officer the power to issue a summons on the spot for dogs without tags

Mr. Weldon said a person guilty of such an offence could pay out of court, similar to a traffic offence.

The Clerk said the fees for animals in Richmond Hill were now more in line with surrounding municipalities.
