Look who's arrived

Richmond Hill's Canada Employment Centre for Students is looking for students who are "Flexible" — willing to work evenings and weekends, or prepared to take a series of casual jobs, or two or three part time jobs.

Supervisor for the centre, Monica Janach, said so far this year they have not received many job orders from employers for normal 40 hour a week jobs.

Up to the end of May most jobs have been for post secondary school males to do heavy outdoor labor or factory work, but recently jobs for females have been "picking up", she said.

To date, 683 students have registered, said Miss Janach, but only 145 job orders have been placed, representing about 175 jobs.

Miss Janach expects these job orders will pick up when people know students are available for employment.

"Flexibility is very important," said the supervisor. "Students should look upon part time work as another avenue in their job search."

Students looking for summer jobs are encouraged to drop in to the centre at 10144 Yonge Street to register and employers with needs for summer help can call 884-1584 for information.

York Regional Police News Briefs

HIGHWAY ROBBERY AT THE DRIVE-IN

On June 1 at about 10:30 p.m., a man who was attending the Odeon Dufferin Drive-In theatre in Concord, drove out to the cashier and approached the wicket after getting out of his car.

He then gave the cashier a plastic bag and told her to put everything she had into it. At the same time, he produced a butcher knife.

As he left, he advised the cashier not to touch the phone for five minutes because he claimed there was another person following him and watching her. He got away with \$250.

The suspect is described as: male, white, 19 to 24-years-old, 6' tall, weighing 145 lbs., having dirty blonde hair parted in the middle and wearing a white dress shirt and blue jeans.

The vehicle he was alleged to be driving was a 1968-1972 pale green two-door Pontiac Laurentian, having a dark vinyl roof. It was described as being in good condition.

MALICIOUS DAMAGE TO THAT SPECIAL TOUCH

Between May 30 at 6 p.m. and May 31 at 7:30 a.m., entry was gained to That Special Touch Gift Shop in the Nobleton Plaza on Hwy. 27 in Nobleton. After the front glass door was smashed, \$37 was taken from the cash register.

Afterwards, \$1,500 damage was done to the front door and an antique cash register.

JAIL FARM FIRE

On June 1 at 9 a.m. a fire broke out in the Russell House Old Jail Farm in Richmond Hill, a property under the authority of the City of Toronto. The cause was not immediately determined but the Richmond Hill Fire Department arrived at the scene within five minutes and extinguished flames that did \$1,000-worth of damage.

WEIGHING IN AT THORNHILL

On June 3 a 14-year-old and a 17-year-old Thornhill youth entered the Thornhill Secondary School on Dudley Ave. in Thornhill by breaking a

south side window. They stole 15 weigh scales and stored them in a field on Elgin St., Thornhill.

On June 3 at 2:30 p.m. as a result of information received, a vehicle driven by two other suspects from Thornhill was stopped. A check of the trunk revealed a weigh scale and later the two occupants, 17 and 15-years-old, led police to the field where the other stolen property was hidden.

As a result all four boys were charged with possession over \$200 and the first pair was also charged with break, enter and theft. They were arrested on Yonge St. in Richmond Hill on June 3 and released for a court appearance on June 26. The juveniles' parents were notified. The offense was detected before the school had a chance to report it.

GUNS AMONG ITEMS MISSING

On May 28 between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., the home of Bruce Bishop on Cartier Cres. in Richmond Hill was entered through an unlocked side door. After a search, six guns, a cassette player and a quantity of jewelry all worth \$1,500 were taken.

After an investigation, York Regional Police were able to recover some of the property but an

18-year-old Hill suspect couldn't be located so a warrant was issued for his arrest.

FRISBEE STILL POPULAR

On April 13 during the early morning hours, a man visited 10610 Bayview Ave. in Richmond Hill. At that time, he picked up a garbage container lid and threw it through the front glass door of York Home TV.

An investigation showed a 17-year-old Richmond Hill youth was responsible and he was arrested for mischief to private property over \$500 on May 30 at 10 p.m. at 28 Division. His parents were notified and he will appear in court on June 25.

TRACTOR, DRIVER RUN AMOK

Between May 26 at 9 a.m. and May 28 at 7 a.m. a tractor belonging to Sunfield Landscaping Ltd. on Bayview Ave. in Thornhill was driven across the sod of the property and into a tree.

The machine was then driven into a lake at the same location, causing damage worth \$5,000. Police have no suspects.
