# Take a good look at Canada and how it has grown

Last week we celebrated the birth of a child who became the patron saint of Quebec, Saint Jean Baptiste.

This week, on July 1, we celebrate the birth of our nation. Let us as Canadians ensure that each one of us will participate thoroughly in the rekindling of our determination to survive as a nation.

First, let us take a closer look at the beginning of Canada as a nation, from its start as a federation of five colonies, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Quebec, Ontario and British Columbia.

The designation of our country as the 'Dominion' of Canada came to the Fathers of Confederation in 1867 as an inspiration from their reading of the Psalms of David.

Our forefathers had been considering possible names for their new country. They had thought of names such as 'United Provinces of Canada', 'Confederacy of Canada', 'Republic of Canada', and so on. Then one morning Sir Samuel Leonard Tilley was reading the Psalms of David.

In Psalm 72 he came to verse 8, which reads 'He shall have dominion from sea to sea, and from the river unto the world's

end.' He stopped, slapped his knee and said to his fellow confederates, 'What an apt description of this new country of ours - from the Atlantic Ocean to the Pacific Ocean, and from the River St. Lawrence to the end of the Arctic Islands?' So the title 'Dominion of Canada' was adopted, along with the Latin motto for our national coat of arms - 'A Mare usque ad Mare' - 'From Sea to Sea'.

From its very beginning this Dominion of Canada has been rooted in the Old Testament Scriptures. Our moral and ethical values are based on our Judeo-Christian heritage.

As Viscount Hailsham said in an address to the Canadian Bar Association, 'Our very laws are derived from the Bible and the Christian Religion'.

This is how, on July 1, 1867, five provinces, richer in faith and in courage than anything else they then realized, joined together to form the Dominion of Canada. There were optimistic speeches made that showed courage and promise. But, there were also foretellers of doom. Some newspapers carried black borders, and some flags were flown at half mast.

But, as we celebrate July 1, 1979, we realize Canada is completely one, from ocean to ocean and from the river to the world's end - 10 provinces and two Arctic territories. It is many times larger in population, in proven natural resources, and in gross national product. We can indeed have a sense of confidence as we look to the future. In fact, other countries have gone so far as to say that the next century is Canada's. Canada's voice is heard in the councils of the nations. She provides food for many peoples throughout the world. She has taken her part in the affairs of the nations of the world, and in the struggles for the freedom of nations and individuals.

In that same Psalm 72 through which the Fathers of Confederation were inspired they read, 'In his days shall the righteous flourish, and abundance of peace'. What happier omen could they wish for the new Dominion of Canada? This was the vision of our forefathers when Canada was born. It is up to us to bring this vision to fruition in the national unity under the guidance of those men and women we have elected as our leaders - to foil them would be tragic.

Canada is big enough and blessed enough for us to welcome some of the people who are not so favoured as we are. Refugees, particularly those from Viet Nam, will bless us as we give them a welcome and a home. Our Lord Jesus said, 'Inasmuch as you have done it unto the least of these my brothers, you have done it unto Me.'
