

Peewee Lions 'B' champs!

The Richmond Hill Peewee Lions bounced back from an opening game 15-2 loss to Markham to win the 'B' championship in the Unionville tournament on the weekend.

That final game saw them downing Unionville

7-3 behind the superb hurling of Don Webster who struck out seven batters.

Richmond Hill picked up three runs in the first inning against Unionville as Glen Harding singled and Jim Anderson bunted safely. Kevin McInnis

was safe on a fielder's choice.

Chris Kostopoulos then singled scoring Anderson and McInnis. Don Webster then brought in Kostopoulos with a single.

Richmond Hill added to its total in the bottom of the fifth inning when Steve Ceballo bunted and

Wayne Murphy was safe on an error. Bert Ball grounded out but Ceballo scored on the play. Billy Keates singled in Murphy.

Unionville picked up one run in the top of the sixth inning but the Lions came back with two more in the bottom when Anderson walked and McInnis singled. Both scored on passed balls.

Unionville scored two more in the top of the seventh but it was not enough. Richmond Hill had 12 hits, made no errors, left nine runners on base.

The opening game against Markham saw The Hill taken to the cleaners. Their only runs came in the first inning when Jim Anderson got on with a walk and scored

on a passed ball; and in the third on Bert Ball's homer.

They went on to drub Uxbridge 12-2 in a game highlighted by a three-run homer by Kevin McInnis. Don Webster went all the way on the mound for the Lions.

In regular league play the Lions are still in first place with 12 wins, 1 loss and 1 tie.
