

York Region police officers commended

Six York Regional Police officers received commendations last week for their work on a case in which an elderly woman died after she was robbed and knocked down by a Newmarket teenager.

Chief Bruce Crawford in his report to the police commission last Wednesday.

Edith Bevington, 72, died three days after she was knocked down on Eagle Street during a purse-snatching incident last Nov. 22. Her purse contained \$12.

The six-man team worked full-time on the case, interviewing "numerous youths" and making "painstaking efforts... to check the alibis of each youth," the chief said.

One youth, Michael Paul Cain, 16, was interviewed a second time after inconsistencies were found in his alibis, and he finally admitted the theft on Nov. 28, the chief said.

Mr. Cain was charged with second-degree murder, but later pleaded guilty to the lesser charge of manslaughter. On April 27, he was sentenced to 21 months in reformatory.

The chief called for the commendations to the six officers "for their excellent example of outstanding police work and the highly professional manner in which their case was presented to the court."
