## Moratorium not advised - Auld

Another letter has been received by the town from the Minister of Energy

supporting Ontario Hydro. Richmond Hill had

asked for a moratorium on the construction of the 500 kV transmission lines and requested an environmental assessment hearing.

The minister, James Auld, pointed out "these lines are needed immediately to enable electricity to be delivered to meet growing demands in Metro Toronto and neighboring areas" and consequently he felt "a three-year moratorium on all transmission lines wishing to help in the program, driving cars or interest.

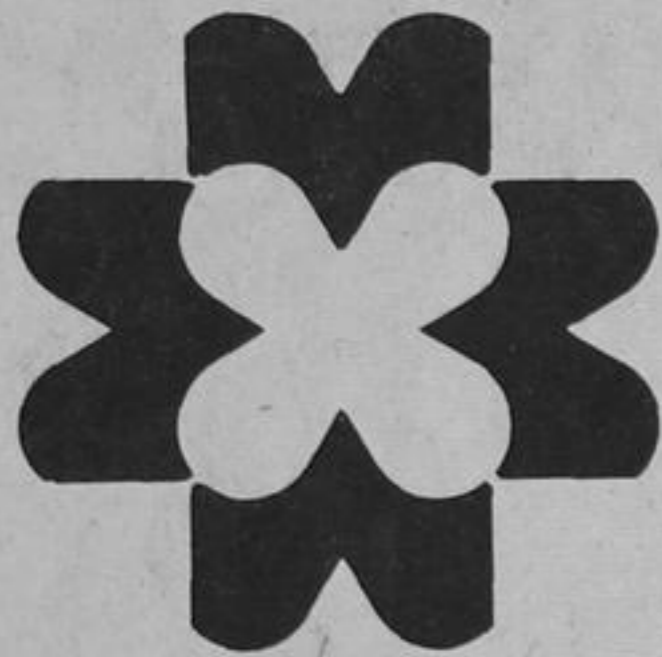
