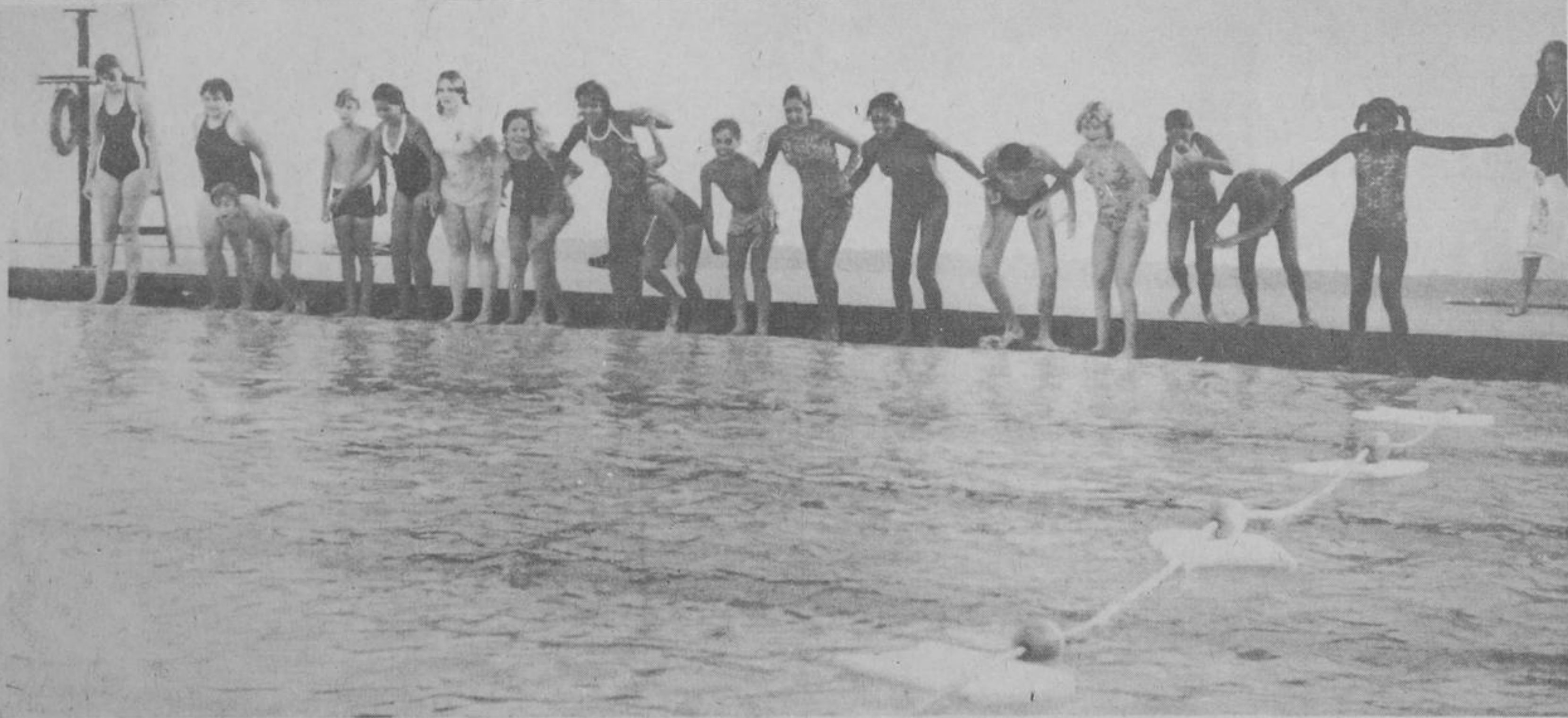

<p><b>Your community needs you</b></p> <p>TO SUPPORT THE RICHMOND HILL VOLUNTEER BUREAU! Your Volunteer Bureau has been in operation since January, 1979 and since that time they have recruited more than 233 volunteers.</p> <p>These volunteers are working with children, doing typing, assisting in programs for the handicapped, organizing activities for community groups, visiting with seniors and a variety of other volunteer jobs.</p> <p>Almost 2-3 of the volunteer work is located within Richmond Hill and the rest are in all parts of York Region — Thornhill, Aurora, Newmarket, Markham, Maple, etc.</p> <p>In addition to recruiting volunteers for community groups and organizations the Volunteer Bureau offers a confidential interview and placement service.</p> <p>This is available to any person who would like to do volunteer work but is unsure of what he or she can do and where their assistance is needed. To date, more than 90 volunteers</p> <p>have been placed through this service.</p> <p>With so many people utilizing the services of the Volunteer Bureau and with the number of community agencies benefiting from the assistance of new volunteers, it would be unfortunate for the Volunteer Bureau to have to close.</p> <p>However, the Volunteer Bureau will be forced to close unless an alternative means of funding can be found.</p> <p>The present source of funding for the Richmond Hill Volunteer Bureau is from a Canada Works grant which will be finished on October 26, 1979.</p> <p>The Volunteer Bureau hopes that the community will support the Bureau for the remaining months of the year, as well as for the year 1980.</p> <p>If you are interested in learning more about the Richmond Hill Volunteer Bureau, the volunteer opportunities available in the area, or want to support the Bureau call 883-2235.</p>
