

"Old Ontario" displayed at Gibson House

"Old Ontario" is the theme of an exhibition by one of Canada's most renowned historical artists.

Dorothy Clark McClure, of Aurora, who designed the cover of The Liberal's Community Guide this year, has been persistent in her effort to capture the fading Canadian past in her race against the wreckers.

Much of her work is now with collectors, but this showing, which starts tomorrow and continues until September 12 at the Gibson House, 5172 Yonge Street, emphasizes a series of watercolors, original sepia sketches and limited lithographic prints.

A special preview will be held August 16 from 7 to 9 p.m. for friends and collectors.

Visitors are welcome from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily Monday to Saturday and from noon to 5 p.m. Sundays and holidays.

Someone took four doors from a vehicle, which had been parked on the premises.


JEWELRY HEIST

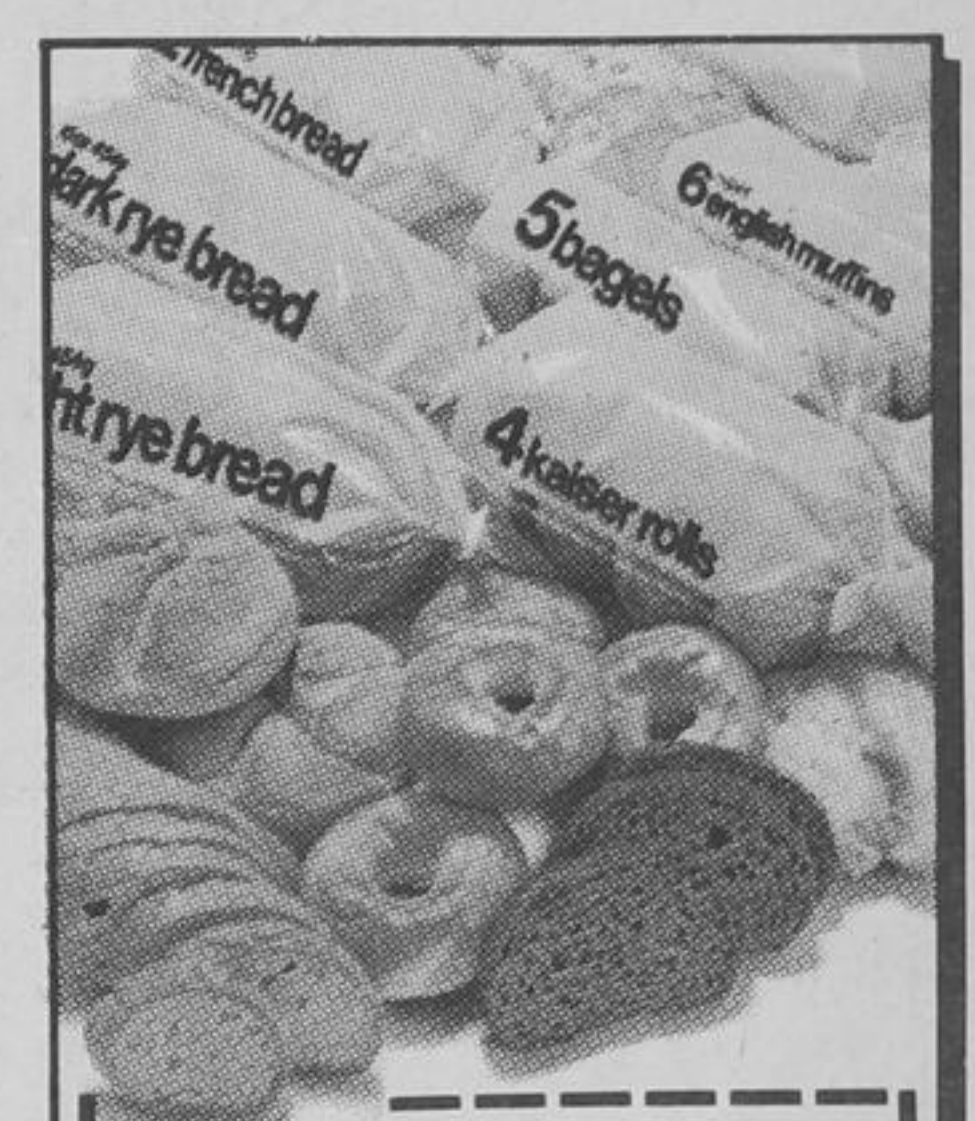
