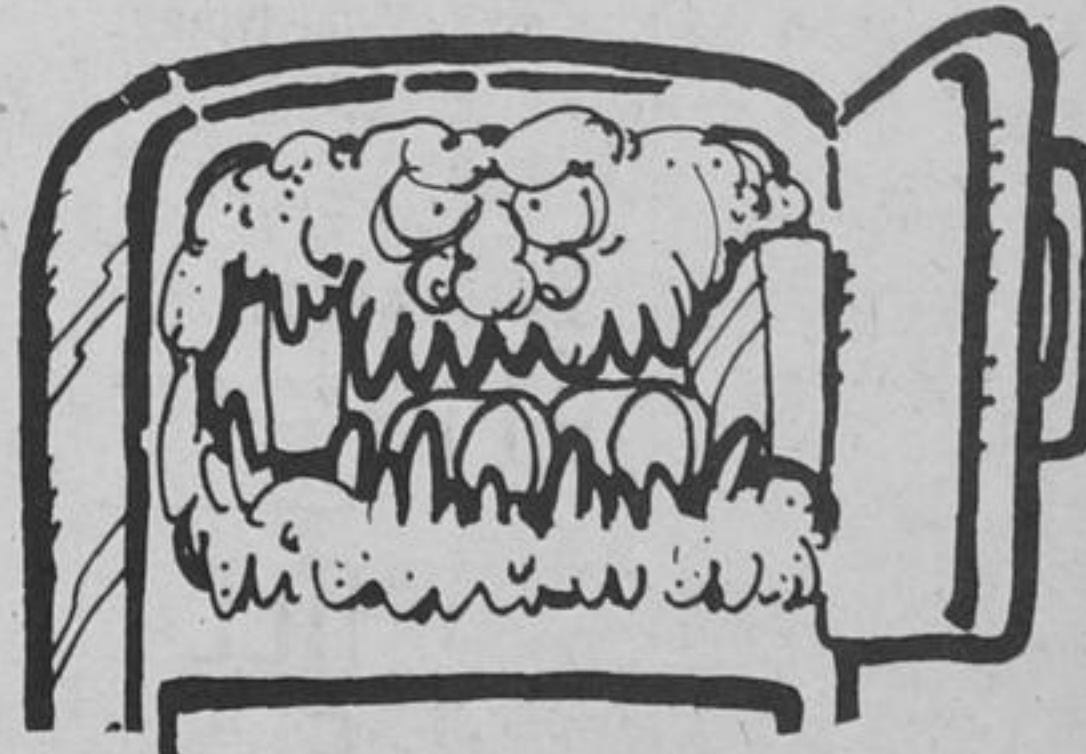
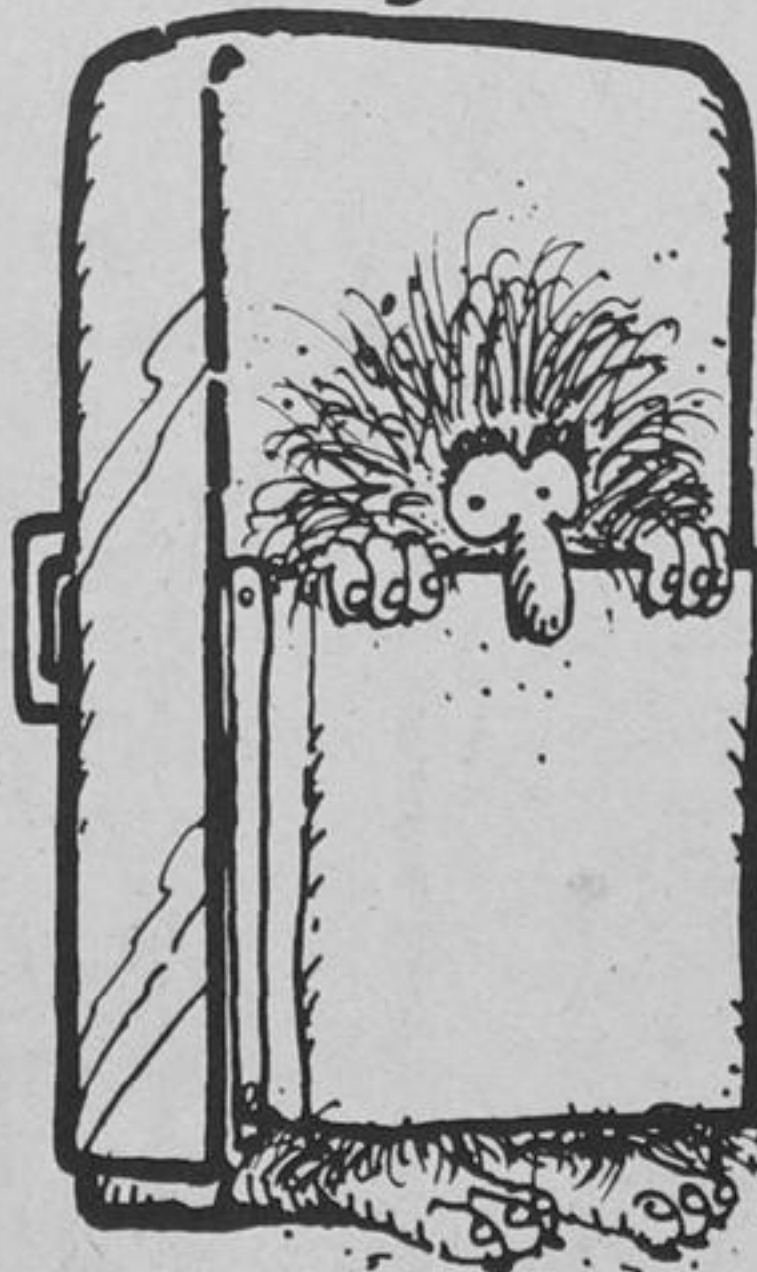

Look who's stealing your electricity.
