With its very own uniform and a fun program, Pathfinders will be attracting all those girls aged 12 to 15 who thought Girl Guides were

too young and Rangers were too challenging for them. Guiding believes they'll find this new concept so interesting and just "grown up" enough that they won't be able to resist trying it.

Along with the new groups will come changes in the other programs as well. The age levels will be lowered by one year
