Bayview Ave. may soon be extended

The end of the line for Bayview Avenue may soon be extended. Bayview Avenue north presently stops at the Gormley Sideroad, but the Region of York's engineering department is proposing to carry out "pre-engineering and preliminary design" for the construction of the road from the Gormley Sideroad north to Bloomington Road. For about 3,000 feet, north of the Gormley Sideroad, there is no road at all. Then Bayview picks up again and as a narrow gravel surface

continues to the south side of Lake Wilcox. The road then curves to the east and follows the east shoreline of the lake to Elgin Grove Road. That section is paved. North from Elgin Grove to the Bloomington, the road has a gravel surface with poor vertical alignment in some areas, an engineering report says. Construction of the road would be a big boost for the Oak Ridges — Lake Wilcox area, Richmond Hill Councillor Bill Corcoran said Monday night.

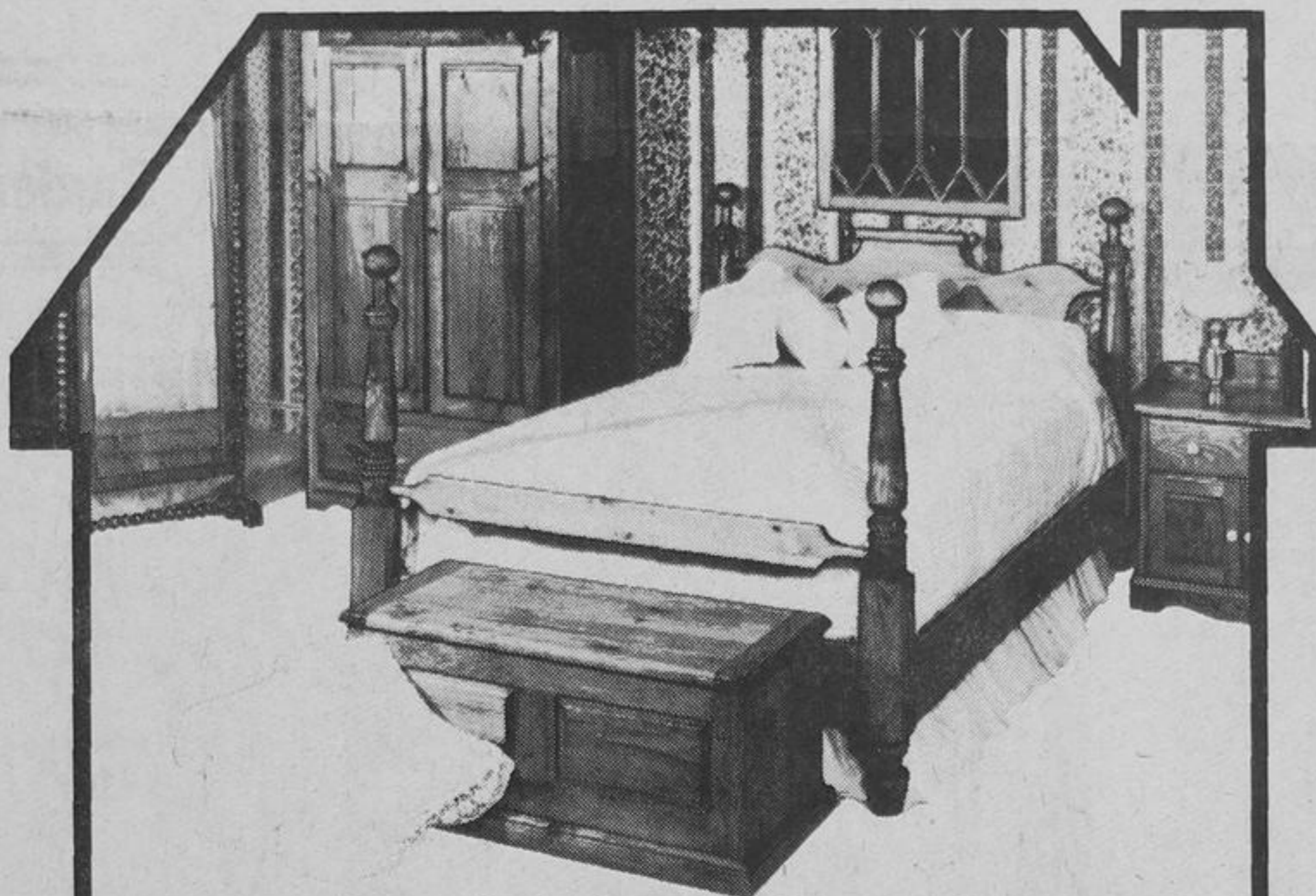

YONGE STREET GO "C" SERVICE
BAYVIEW-FINCH GO SERVICE
Effective October 1, 1979

Fares on GO Bus local services between Richmond Hill and Finch Subway will be revised as follows:

ADULT	50¢
STUDENT	35¢
CHILD 12 & under	25¢
SENIOR CITIZEN	25¢

Fares are exact cash; no tickets available.

Free transfer from GO local service to Markham Transit and to Richmond Hill Transit (except Route 4A, Oak Ridges).

Free transfer from Markham Transit to GO local service buses (except at Finch).

Transfer from Richmond Hill Transit (except from Oak Ridges route) with payment of additional ten cents (10¢).

These fares change the Bayview service from a 2-zone to a single zone system. The change establishes a common fare structure for Markham Transit and GO local services.

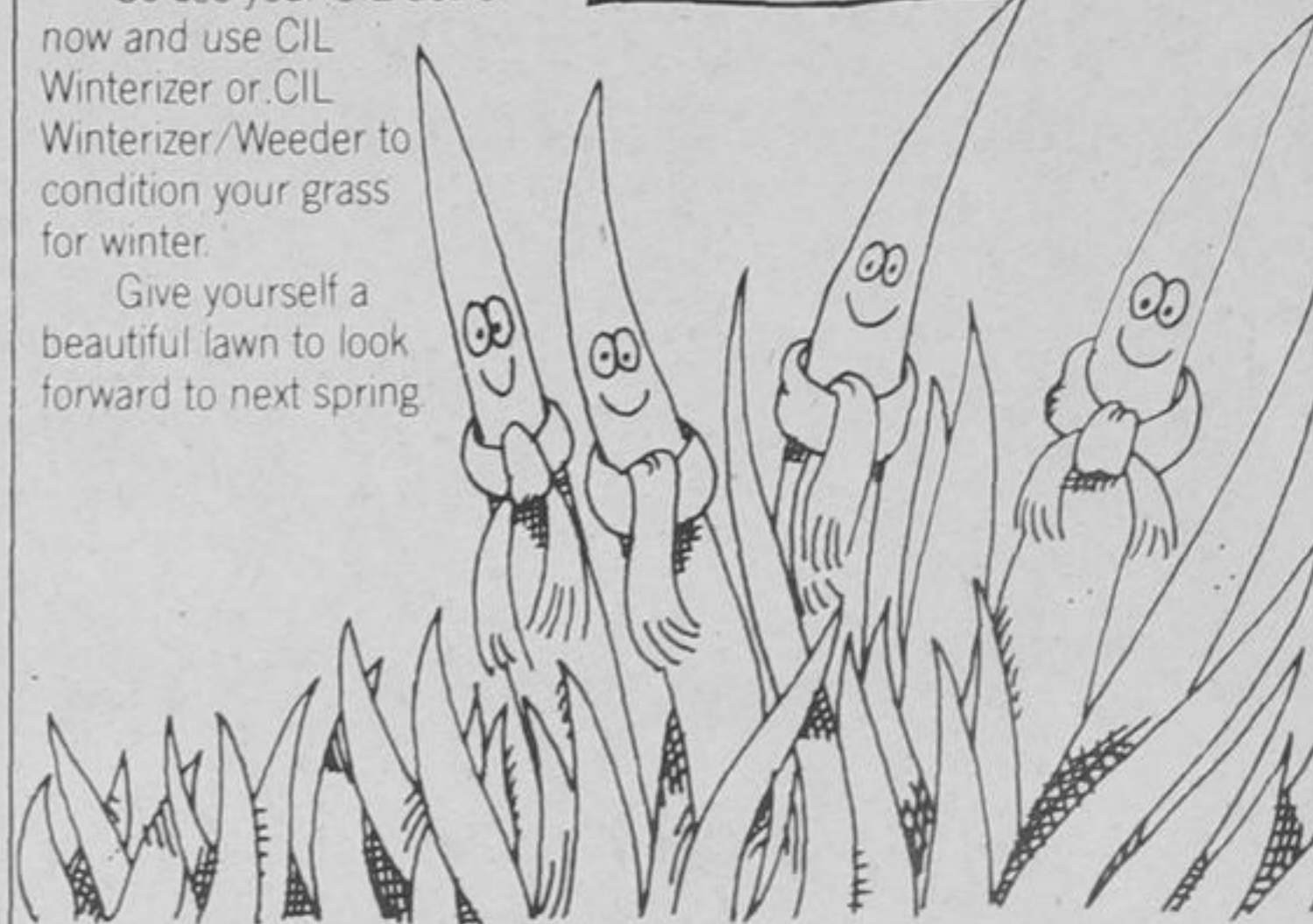
