

## Yellow Brick House seeks location here

The Yellow Brick House, an emergency housing facility for women and children in York Region, is looking for a new home — preferably in the Richmond Hill area.

Reports that such a facility has been acquired in Richmond Hill are incorrect said Michael Crowley, president of the Board of Directors of Project HOSTEL, the organization responsible for the Yellow Brick House.

"We want to move to the Richmond Hill area," said Mr. Crowley, and that's where we're looking... but nothing is definite."

Mr. Crowley pointed out at this time the organization is looking to the government for funding hoping to be able to build a facility, but nothing is firm as yet.

Director of the Yellow Brick House, Maggie Partland, said studies done with regional planning staff indicate the largest population growth will be in the southern part of the region and the board feels to serve the needs of their clients it would be best to be close to the Yonge Street corridor.

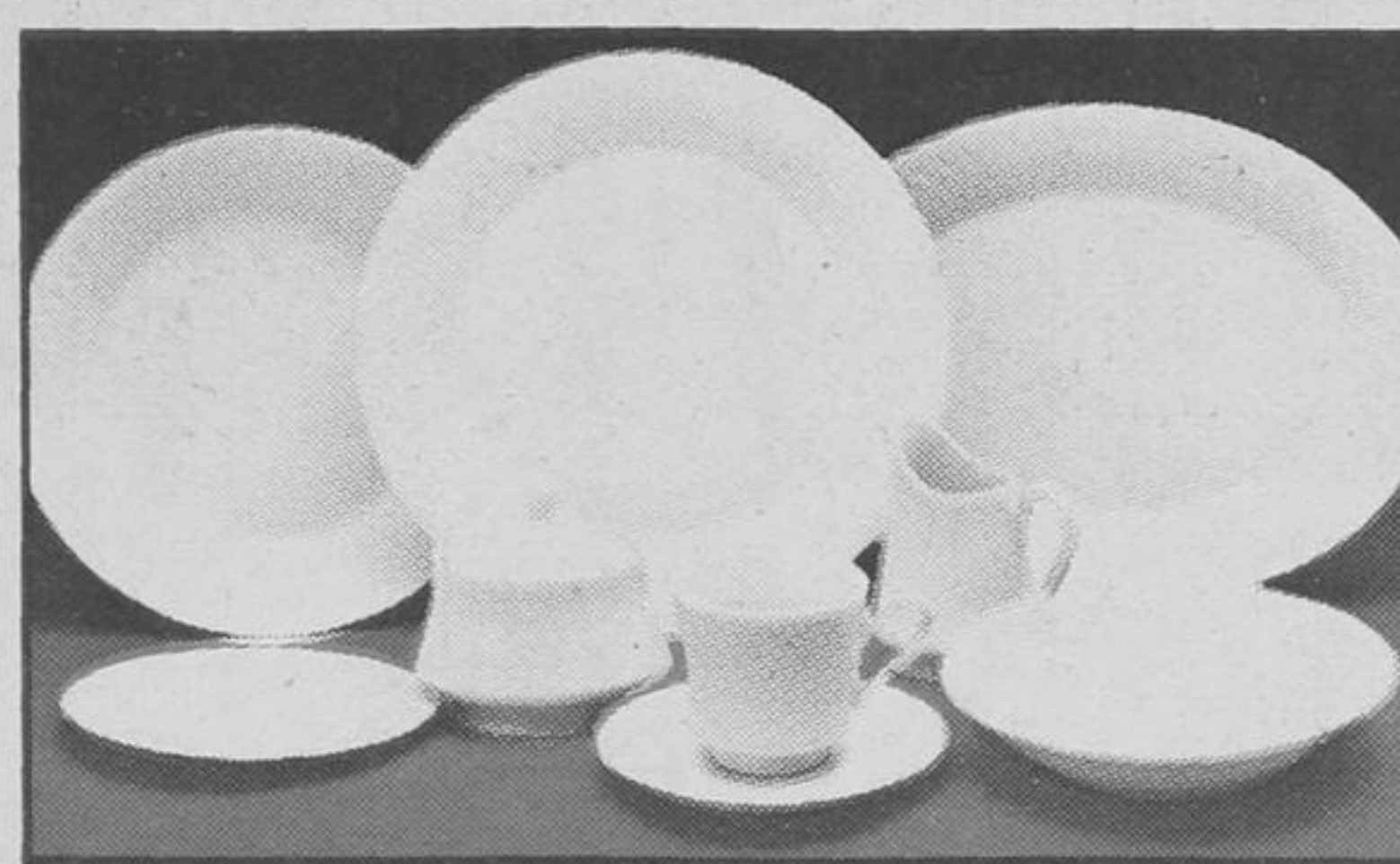
