Minister seeks identity of Church

The challenge facing The Reverend Patrick White, the new minister at St. John's Anglican Church, is to try to find out where St. John's is. "I've been trying to discover the dimensions of the community," he said, "on both a personal

and geographical level." Mr. White took up his duties at St. John's, Jefferson, in September of this year and said he feels a need to draw his parishioners into a community, with an identity — even though they are geographically

spread among Newmarket, Aurora, Richmond Hill, Vancor and Gormley. St. John's Anglican Church is located south of the Gormley-Stouffville Sideroad, in Richmond Hill. The new minister said

he would like to make the congregation more visible, "but it's hard to know where St. John's is," he said. Before coming to St. John's, The Reverend Patrick White spent two years at St. Matthew's Anglican Church in

Islington.

October 1, Mr. White, his wife Elizabeth, and their two daughters, Jennifer 8, and Rebecca 6, moved into the rectory. Jennifer and Rebecca attend Jefferson Public School.
