There's local flavor at the Richmond Inn this week.

Thin Ice—a new group this year is led by Richmond Hill's Don Amodeo, and bolstered by Hill singer Alan Sare.

At the end of 1978, the idea of forming a rock band and getting onto the Ontario Club circuit came to Amodeo.

The young guitarist searched the Metropolitan Toronto area for fellow musicians with the same ambition and determination.

The band was formed and by early 1979 had reached its first short-term goal.

As time passed, a few personnel changes finally resulted in the unique formula which became Thin Ice.

Amodeo, who lives on Centre Street in the Hill,

is the leader and main composer of the Thin Ice music, along with Chuck Sanders, an electrifying guitarist who stimulates the senses with his lead guitar work.

Among the new personnel is bassist-vocalist Alan Sare, brother of folk artist Ray Sare, of Richmond Hill, who puts out solid bass rhythm and adds another dimension of color to the Thin Ice sound with his Moog bass pedals.

Finally, providing the steady powerful heartbeat of the group, is drummer Al Pantone, who also does a great deal of vocal work.

The Thin Ice show itself makes use of the individual and collective talents of its members.
