**Bayview hockey gals in finals**

The Bayview Secondary School of Richmond Hill girls senior field hockey team swept into the finals of the York County league Monday by blanking Aurora High School 1-0.  
Bayview's win in the sudden death game, coupled with Dr. G. W. Williams of Aurora's 1-0 defeat of Thornhill Secondary, matches the two teams up in the finals.  
That final will take place today (Wednesday) on a neutral field at King City.

Kathryn Rumney was the heroine again for Bayview as she scored the only goal of the game.  
"The whole team played solidly," said coach Diana Martyn, "and if they can keep that up we should do all right against G.W. Williams."  
Bayview finished on top of the southern half of the York County while Williams finished first in the north.  
"It should be interesting," continued Martyn. "We've never seen Williams play this season."  
Bayview's record to date is six wins and a tie.  
Coach Martyn is also looking for strong play from her captain Diane Eldridge at centre half and also from Debbie Murray who "is capable of scoring a lot of goals."  
While the game with Williams will decide the York County title, both teams will be eligible for the Georgian Bay tomorrow (Thursday).  
The two top teams in the York divisions qualify for the Georgian Bay.
