

## Library officially opens facility for handicapped

More than 100 people attended Monday's official opening of the new facilities for the handicapped at Richmond Hill Public Library. An Outreach grant from Wintario made renovating the library possible and the new ramp for wheelchairs, elevator from one level to another and modifications to washrooms will make it much easier for handicapped people to enjoy the library.

Presiding at the opening ceremonies were Alf Stong, MLA-York Centre; Mayor David Schiller; Ella Bremner, Chairman of the Library Board; and Betty Rowland, Chief Librarian.

Guests were invited to tour the premises, enjoy musical entertainment by a woodwind quintet from

the York Symphony Orchestra, join in a folk singing session with Martha Dynes and see a series of four short films.

At the ribbon cutting ceremonies, Gordon Snyder, a resident of The Villa Hospital in Richmond Hill cut the ribbon.

Visitors and officials joined library staff for refreshments following the official portion of the program.

Continuing with special programs for the handicapped, on Saturday, November 3 at 2 p.m. there will be a program for handicapped children at the library.

Laurie Knight, an area ventriloquist and Abra the Magi-clown will be on hand to entertain the youngsters, who are all invited to stay for refreshments following the program.

## Defendant loses cool in trial

Errol Michael Figuera, 25, became upset and had to be restrained Monday as his trial for the murder of Richard Lusk entered its second week in Toronto.

What upset Figuera was the testimony of York Regional Police Constable Bill Whyte who said he saw blood on the accused's hand and on the murder weapon, a large knife.

The judge ordered a 20-minute recess until Figuera settled down.

Figuera is charged with second degree murder as a result of a dispute a year ago August in the hallway of a Thornhill apartment building.

During the dispute, Richard Lusk, a resident of Oak Ridges, was celebrating his birthday when he was fatally stabbed and several others of the Lusk party were wounded.

Police kicked in the door of the Figuera

apartment and found the accused with the murder weapon in his hands. Constable Whyte told the court.

Figuera was arrested

and charged with the crime.

Crown witnesses were heard during the first week of the trial and Monday and Tuesday.

York Regional Police presented its case.

Defense witnesses are expected to begin testifying today (Wednesday).

When complete, the 16,000 square foot

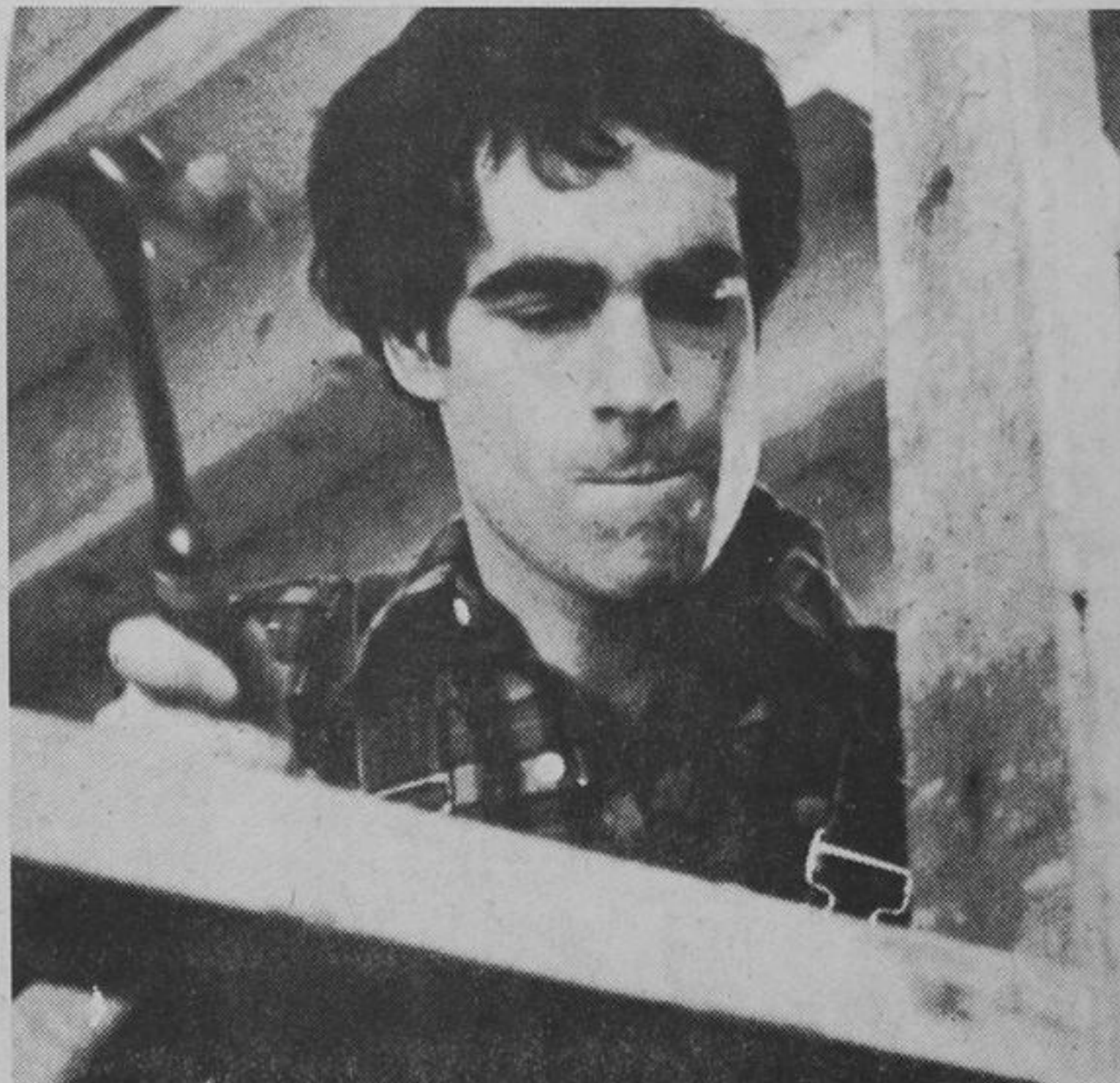
famous singers, died Thursday at Richmond Hill's York Central
