

Church group plans door-to-door canvas

"A knock on your door during the next few weeks could be a friend from the Richmond Hill Seventh-day Adventist Church calling," says E. L. Anderson, the pastor. "Volunteers will be visiting homes and businesses as part of the annual World Service Appeal between now and Christmas." Mr.

Anderson said. "Each year members of the world-wide church gather funds for humanitarian work, and give a report on how previous donations were spent. Last year, members raised more than \$8.6 million, distributed 14.5 million items of clothing, and gave more than \$6.5 million in food and cash

through person-to-person services." Mr. Anderson said the 120 members of the Richmond Hill church will be actively involved in this voluntary effort, some as visitors, others as drivers, Christmas carolers, and behind-the-scenes workers. "All funds are administered through

existing church channels," he said, "so we don't have the embarrassing problem of administration eating up this money earmarked for relief work." The Adventist Church operates more than 400 hospitals, clinics, dispensaries, medical planes, and mission launches around the

world. The work is conducted without regard to race or creed — Christians and Muslims in Lebanon, for instance, are being treated equally. The Metro area Community Service Units supply good clothing and sometimes food and other necessary items to needy families. A phone call to the local Co-

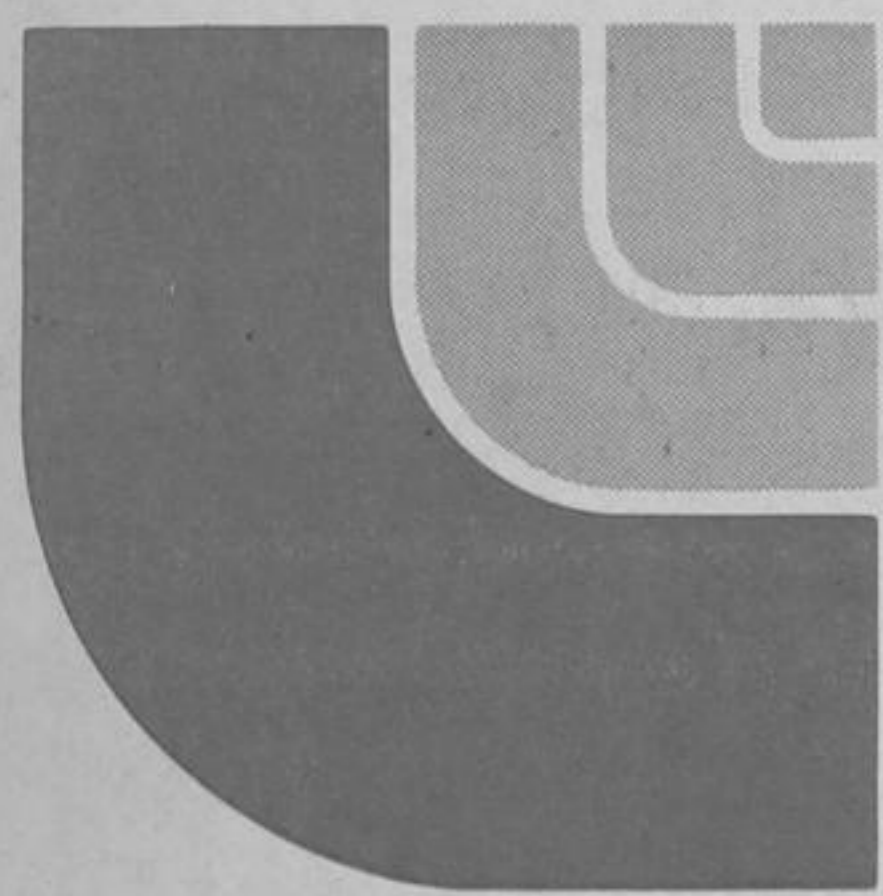
ordinator at 884-6555 will activate this service. "We hope our members will have a chance to get better acquainted with the people of Richmond Hill," Mr. Anderson said. "We invite the public to participate in our program only once a year, and many new families have moved here since last Christmas."
