There has been a series of house break-ins in the Thornhill area in the past week.
 Charlotte Munroe of 51 Almond Avenue is missing a quantity of jewelry after her home was broken into on November 19.
 The home of Van Petroff, 51 Fairway Heights Drive, Thornhill was broken into November 20 and a quantity of jewelry, coins and cash was taken.
 Between November 9 and November 23 someone broke into the home of Sharon Lynn Moriarty, 11 Marsnow Drive, Thornhill and took an unknown quantity of jewelry.
 On November 25 a quantity of cash was taken from the master bedroom of Rowland B. Hill, 47 Bowman Way, Thornhill.

WINDOWS SMASHED
 Two Richmond Hill schools were victims of malicious damage.
 Someone smashed a window at Walter Scott Public School and the same night, someone smashed 69 windows at Bayview Secondary School. The damage to Bayview Secondary School is estimated at \$4,000.

 A person gained admittance to Shouldice Hospital on the weekend by claiming to be a friend of the cleaning staff.
 After the person left the hospital, staff noticed a quantity of drugs was missing.

BUS RIDER

 Damage to the buses is estimated at \$1,000.

 Another incident at the same location involved malicious damage.
 On November 22 someone removed a flatbed trailer belonging to Jack Westerhock, 12 Elizabeth Street, Thornhill and took it to John and Yonge Streets in Thornhill, where it was abandoned.

FATAL CRASH
 A motor vehicle collision at the corner of 17th Avenue and Kennedy Road, Markham on Friday, November 23 took the lives of a 16-year-old woman and a three-year-old boy.
 The vehicle, driven by 16-year-old Denise Spencely of Cannington, was eastbound on 17th Avenue.
 Her vehicle was struck by a northbound vehicle.
 Miss Spencely was taken to York Central Hospital, where she was pronounced dead on arrival.
 Two passengers in her car, Diane Weedman, 37, also of Cannington was taken to Sunnybrook Hospital and Gregory Weedman, 3, of the same address was rushed to the Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto, where he died the next day of multiple injuries.
