

Christmas forces postponement of library meet

The holiday season is getting too close for comfort so Mayor Dave Schiller and Chief Librarian for Richmond Hill, Betty Rowland, have decided to postpone a public meeting to review the Richvale library situation.

At a meeting November 12 the town was asked to set up a public meeting to

get input from residents into the location of a library facility in the Richvale area.

The Library Board would like to see a new facility at the Richvale Community Centre to replace the present building on Pearson Avenue, which they feel is overcrowded.

Many of the residents living south of Carrville

Road want the library to remain where it is.

Mayor Schiller said a meeting in January would allow each side to present arguments and still allow adequate time for a decision to be included in the 1980 capital budget process.

At this time neither location nor date is available for a public meeting.

Curtain Club presentation opens tomorrow

What does a 20th century playwright like Christopher Frye do with a story about a 14th Century witch? A LOT.

The medieval setting of 'The Lady's Not for Burning' makes an excellent vehicle for a little bawd, a little romance and a lighthearted examination of philosophical, religious and moral issues that are always relevant.

This playwright asks the question "why" with a sense of humor and the answers he gets are always flippant.

The perspectives he

gives the audience are satisfying.

The Curtain Club's production of the play conveys the spirit well.

The costumes (Suzanne Stoner) and set (by Buster Vermeulin, a local artist) are rendered convincingly in traditional medieval style.

The effects, lights (Alex Kanerek, who also acts in the play) and sound (Pat Kantoroff) also contribute to the frivolous mood.

The end result is the creation of another world that's full of whimsy.

Still, as in all comedies, there's a heavier side.

Genet (Tina Kanerek) is, after all, the victim of a witch hunt and she is innocent.

During the eve of burning festivities Genet does indeed manage to enchant the other characters but it is with "gentleness, consideration and gaiety".

The trouble is that she's also the kind of temptation that causes the male characters of the play to forget about salvation altogether.

She's the kind of character who alters

everyone's perspective of life in some way.

This is why the citizens of the town feel she's so dangerous.

It's also the reason for her charm.

The play opens tomorrow, Thursday,

November 29 and runs until Saturday, December 15.

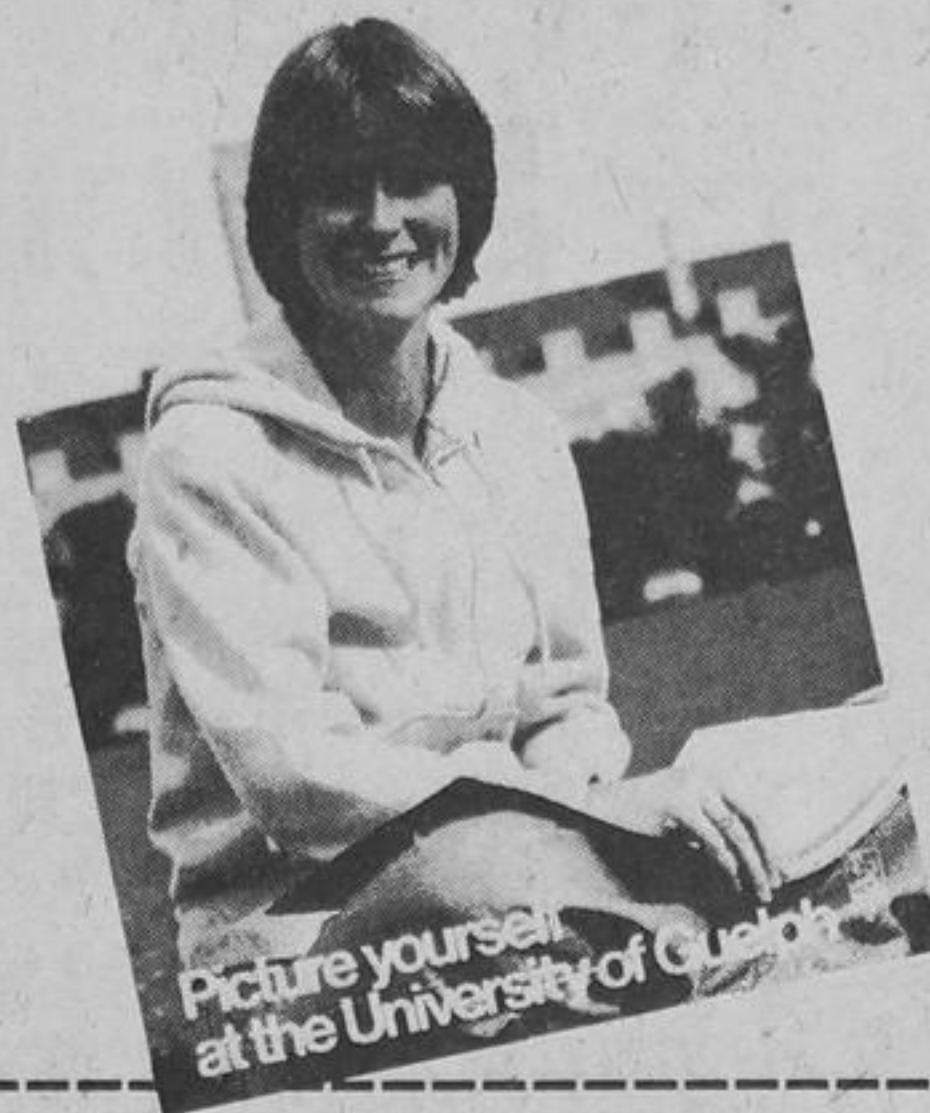
