

Police search cycle club

Eight people have been arrested and charged with various weapons offences, robbery, possession of stolen goods and other offenses as a result of a police search at a Vaughan residence last week.

On December 5, a search warrant was executed at a Major Mackenzie Drive house in the Town of Vaughan.

At the time, eight people, believed to be members or associates of the Outlaws of Canada Motorcycle Club, were arrested and charged with four counts of unsafe weapons storage, two counts of possession of restricted weapons, possession of weapons dangerous, possession of stolen goods under

\$200, obstructing police officers, possession of narcotics and two outstanding warrants from Metropolitan Toronto Police; indecent assault female and robbery.

The search by police revealed two loaded restricted weapons, one loaded shot gun, one loaded .22 calibre rifle, a quantity of narcotics, other restricted weapons and stolen identification.

Another restricted weapon was located outside the residence and police are still investigating.

York Regional Police detectives were involved as were Metropolitan Toronto Police Intelligence and the OPP Intelligence Units.

The arrested were not

local residents. Some came from Windsor, others from Hamilton, Ottawa, and Toronto.

They were held for a hearing December 6.

THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK

STOUFFVILLE ROAD CLOSING

(Regional Road No. 14)

THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK PROPOSES TO PASS A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING:

1. the stopping up and closing of existing Regional Road No. 14 (Stouffville Road) in the Hamlet of Gormley between the west and east limits of the CNR right-of-way in Concession 3 of the Town of Richmond Hill (formerly the Township of Whitchurch); and
2. the construction of turning basins on the existing Regional Road No. 14 (Stouffville Road) in the Hamlet of Gormley adjacent to the west and east limits of the CNR right-of-way crossing Regional Road No. 14 (Stouffville Road) in Concession 3 of the Town of Richmond Hill (formerly Township of Whitchurch).

Pursuant to section 446 of The Municipal Act, the Engineering Committee of the Regional Council will, at its meeting to be held at 2:00 p.m. on the 8th day of January 1980, at the Engineering Building on the west side of Woodbine Avenue one and one quarter miles north of the Aurora Sideroad, hear any person who claims that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard. Anyone wishing to be heard is requested to advise the undersigned prior to the meeting. If any party entitled to be heard does not attend at the hearing, the Committee may proceed in his absence and he will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceedings.
