

# York Regional Police News Briefs

Two Toronto men have been charged with break, enter and theft; conspiracy to commit break, enter and theft; theft over \$200; and possession of stolen property following investigations into housebreak-ins in Thornhill. Police were investigating several housebreak-ins in the Forest Park Crescent area of Thornhill and the two accused were charged.

**JUVENILE ARRESTED**  
A Richmond Hill juvenile has been charged with break, enter and theft as a result of a break-in at the home of Elizabeth Bradshaw, Elmwood Avenue, Richmond Hill.

**MARKHAM HOUSE BREAK-INS**  
Several homes in Markham were broken into in the past week.

On December 12 the premises of Robert J. Bunting, of Concession 7 were entered through an unlocked door and jewelry, liquor and two radio speakers were taken.

On the evening of December 15-16 someone pried open the door at the home of George Masson, Sir Lancelot Drive and ransacked the rooms, taking camera equipment and jewelry.

Also the same evening, the home of Norman Tasch, Wootton Way, Markham was broken into and a quantity of jewelry was taken.

Collin MacFarlane of Wootton Way was another victim of a break-in on December 15. Someone forced open a window and took a

quantity of jewelry.

**SHOPS HIT IN MARKHAM**  
The Sherwood Steakhouse on Wellington Street West was broken into on December 10-11, when someone climbed in a second floor window.

A quantity of cash and 12 bottles of liquor were taken.

On the same evening of December 14-15 two break-ins occurred at the same address in Markham.

Bristol Truck Rental, 7634 Woodbine Avenue had a tool box and a radio taken and Vital Centre Woodbine was broken into, but nothing appears to be missing.

On the evening of December 16-17 someone broke into Galatti Antiques on Highway 48 and took cash and two 12 gauge shotguns.

**MALICIOUS DAMAGE**  
Thornhaven School on Centre Street, Richmond Hill was the victim of malicious damage on the evening of December 14-15, when someone threw rocks through 12 windows. Damages are estimated at \$1,000.

On the same evening, someone damaged 12 small windows at St. Andrew's United Church, Markham. The damages are estimated at \$100.

Crosby School in Richmond Hill was also the victim of broken windows. On December 15 someone broke five windows in the school.
