**TOWNSHIP OF OSGOODE
 MINUTES**

Town Hall, Metcalfe, May 4th, 1907
 Pursuant to adjournment the Coun-
 cil met at the hour of one o'clock p.
 m. All the members present. Minutes
 of last meeting were read and approv-
 ed.

The following accounts were read
 and filed, viz:—The accounts of
 Earnest Goode, Jas Johnston and
 Sandy McLean for board and assist-
 ance rendered to the Engineer in
 connection with the survey of the Mc
 Cormick drain. Account of Samuel
 Woods for wood for stone crusher
 and helping the engineer. Telephone
 account for March and April. Letter
 from H B Spencer re enlarging the
 culvert where the Doyle Creek crosses
 the railway. Account of the Robert
 Bell Thresher and Engine Co. The
 Journal account. Municipal World
 account. The account of Jas. Moses.

Moved by A Walker seconded by
 Jas McCormick that the minutes as
 read be adopted. Carried.

Moved by Mr Clelland seconded by
 Mr McEvoy that this council give A
 Bower liberty to keep gates on the
 road on lot 27, con. 3, until 1st day
 of September, 1907, on road leading
 from Prescott Road to the line be-
 tween the 3rd and 4th Con. Carried

Moved by Jas McCormick sec by
 A Walker that the Clerk be instructed
 to notify Engineer Walker that in the
 award he is making on the McCor-
 mick and Goode drainage scheme
 this council having been informed
 that he has left the natural course of
 the water and is running his drain on
 the road allowance opposite lot 34 in
 the 10th con. on east side, this coun-
 cil will appeal against any award so
 leaving a natural watercourse and
 making a dangerous drain on the road
 And also that on the same scheme
 there is a short branch coming from

James McCormick's land in the 10th
 con. lot 37. This Council recommends
 that this branch be left out of the
 scheme as Messrs McCormick and
 Stewart have agreed to take the water
 off the side road across their land for
 the sum of five dollars. Carried

Moved by J McEvoy sec by Theo
 Clelland that this corporation do agree
 to pay one quarter the cost of a tile
 drain at Spring Hill cemetery, said
 ditch to cross the Concession Road
 between the 6th and 7th con. and a-
 bout sixty rods on said road, and the
 Clerk be instructed to draw the ne-
 cessary agreement for the interested
 parties. Carried

 A Walker that the engineers report on
 the McCaul drain be now read.

 structed to sign the McCaul Creek
 petition for the Municipality Carried

Moved by Theo Clelland sec by J
 McCormick that J McEvoy be au-
 thorized to build a culvert on the
 nine mile road between lots 20 and 21
 con 3. Also repair the road between
 lots 20 and 21 con 4 Carried

Moved by A Walker sec by J Mc
 McCormick that the Court of Revis-
 ion for the Assessment Roll of the
 Township of Osgoode for the year
 1907 be held on Saturday June 1st at
 10 o'clock a. m. Carried

Moved by A Walker sec by by Jas
 McCormick that the Treasurer be au-
 thorized to borrow by way of over-
 draft from the Union Bank here the
 sum of fourteen hundred dollars on
 the Statute Labor account 1907

 Moved by J McEvoy sec by Theo
 Clelland that the report of Engineer
 Walker on the McCaul drainage
 scheme be adopted and that the clerk
 be instructed to prepare the necessary
 by-law Carried

Moved by T Clelland sec by J Mc
 McCormick that the Reeve and Treas-
 urer be authorized to renew a note
 for \$9719 \$1 made on Jan. 28th by
 By-Lay on Castor Drain due May 3rd
 at the Union Bank Metcalfe for three
 months. Carried

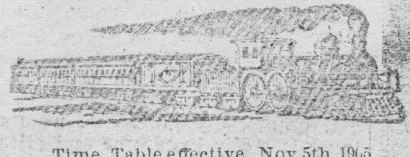
Moved by A Walker sec by Jas

 lage of Metcalfe and that the Treas-

 Metcalfe be advanced out of the Gen-
 eral overdraft the sum of Two Hun-
 dred Dollars Carried
