### NEWS OF THE WORLD

Mr Arthur Meighen, M.P. for Portage la Prairie, and an able young lawyer, has been appointed Solicitor General for Canada.

A homing pigeon, taken from New York to Rio Janiero, Brazil, and liberated there, arrived back in New York after a 48-days flight. The distance is 4,200 miles and this is the first known case of a homing pigeon being able to stand the excessive heat experienced in crossing the equatorial regions.

The committee of prominent Canadian physicians who investigated the effect of the Friedman serum on tuberculous patients treated in Canada found that the results have been disappointing and that the claims made for his remedy by Dr Friedman have not been proved and that nothing has been found to justify any confidence in the remedy.
