Plants That Follow the Sun.

At this time of the year runner beans and many other climbing plants are making their way up the hopes that support them. If you examine them you will find that those which climb by twining always twist in the same direction.

The hop and the honeysuckle turn from left to right. The reason for this is that the sun moves in the same direction and the plants follow him. The side of the shoot which is turned towards the sun grows faster than that which is in the shadow, and the result is that the stalk is forced into a "clockwise" curve.

The runner bean, however, and many other plants, twist in the opposite direction. At first sight you might think that this disproved the explanation given above; but in reality Plants of this kind are affected differently by strong light and the heat of the sun. In their case, the side of the shoot which faces the sun shrinks a little under the heat and wraps the whole stalk into an "anticlockwise" curve.
