



A BY-LAW to raise \$50,000f to aid in the construction of tile, stone or timber drains.

OSGOODE

The Council of the Municipality of the Township of Osenade nursuant to the previsions of the Tile Drainage Act. enasts as follows:-1. That the Reeve may from time to time, subject to the provisions of this Ry-law, horrow o the credit of the corporation of the said Municigality such sume not exceeding in the whole \$50.000, as

may be determined by the Council and may in manner bereinafter nrovided, issue dehentures of the said corneration in such sums as the Council may deem proper for the amount so borrowed, with coupens attached as provided in section 5 of the sold Act

2 That when the Council shall be of opinion that the application of any person to borrow money for the purnese of constructing a tile stone or timber drain should be granted in whole or in part, the Council may, hyresolution, direct the Reeve to issue debentures as aforesaid. and to borrow a sum not exceeding the amount applied fer, and may lend the same to the applicant of the completion of the drainage

3 A anecial annual rate shall be imposed, levied and collected over and above all other rates upon the land in respect of which the said money shall be borrowed, sufficient for the payment of the principal and interest as provided by the Act.
