Ontario's Tobacco Crop Was Sold Within Ten Days

Canada's Newest Large Agricultural Crop Unique on This Continent—Growers and Buyers Budget Production.

SIMCOE, ONT.—With the final curtain rung down today on the 1937 tobacco market, growers of Canada's newest large agricultural crop were able to reckon their profits in excess of \$100 per acre.

This year's market, which saw 56 million pounds of flue-cured tobacco snapped up by buyers in less than ten days, realized in excess of fifteen million dollars for the 1,700 producers who this spring planted 50,500 acres to the crop. Available figures show that tobacco produced a return of approximately \$300 per acre.

Chief problem until 1934 was marketing. Today Ontario's flue-cured tobacco growers belong to a marketing association which rigidly controls price and acreage. Each year, with the co-operation of the prospective buyers of the crop, the tobacco production is "budgeted" and the planting is done purely on a basis of the available market for that year's crop, taking into consideration, of course, growing export prospects. The growers who comprise the association are allotted certain acreages to plant to tobacco.

Growers' Agreement
When the crop is harvested, representatives of growers and buyers—all joint members of the marketing association—meet and agree on an average minimum price for the crop. In 1936, for instance, the average minimum was set at 25 cents per pound, but the price actually paid was 29 cents. This year the average minimum was 24 1/2 cents and the price paid will probably exceed 27 cents.

With the co-operation of the farmer and the buyer, a crop of 56 million pounds—more than twice the 1936 production—was moved this year at a price which sets a new high record for returns.

Today the tobacco industry in Canada is unique on the North American continent in that growers and buyers budget the annual production months ahead of time, amicably agree upon a fixed price which permits a substantial profit for all branches, and work hand in hand for future expansion.

Married, Divorced Inside Two Hours

Reno, famous for speedy divorces, will have to look to its laurels. In Jugoslavia a man has succeeded in being married and divorced all within two hours.

The man signed his marriage contract at nine o'clock one morning. An hour later he discovered that his bride, who was supposed to be 16 years of age, was only 14. By 11 o'clock he had obtained a divorce.

He is now suing the bride's father for return of the \$450 he paid to him.

Penitentiary Takes To Broadcasting

Convicts in the State Penitentiary at Melbourne, Australia, went on the air recently, in the first radio broadcast of its kind in Victoria.

From the prison concert hall, before an audience of 800 inmates, the convicts presented a typical "variety" program.

The audience yelled in appreciation when one of the performers announced gravely: "We must decline any other radio engagements because we will be fully occupied here for the next few months."

Deep Plowing Smothers Grasshoppers' Eggs

Grasshopper eggs are now in the ground, like seeds for next year's crop of troubles, and farmers are concerned how to destroy as many as possible. They must be plowed under deep, advises F. Gray Butcher, extension entomologist and plant pathologist of North Dakota Agricultural College.

Disking and shallow cultivation will not bury them deeply enough to smother the young 'hoppers when they emerge next Spring.

Some of the eggs may be killed by exposure to the frozen drought of Winter, but that will not account for any important percentage of them. Best of all is to watch the crowds of young grasshoppers in Spring and give them a timely Borgia banquet of poisoned bran.

Australian "Charm" Industry Flourishes

Popular Rabbit's Foot Has Been Replaced to a Great Extent by Lodestones, Golden Balls, Medallions and Rings.

More than 250,000 "lucky charms" are sold every year in New South Wales.

"Nine out of ten people in all walks of life are wearers of charms," said the manager of a shop in Sydney which supplies these and other novelties.

"They go out of fashion just like women's hats," he added, "and new charms are manufactured to take their place."

Many airmen will not go up without their rabbit's foot, and many a home hangs holly to chase away the evil spirits. But just now in Sydney there is a great run on lodestones, golden balls, medallions and lucky rings.
