 one of three wells sampled. Mr. Benoit emphasized that blasting would not effect water quality.
 The survey found bacteria entering two out of three wells tested in Metcalfe. At Embrun, six wells were tested five showing various levels of contamination.
 Mr. Benoit said substandard septic tank systems are the cause of bacterial count in Embrun Wells. The problem will probably not be rectified until sewer and water works are completed in the village within three years.
