

CASTOR CUPBOARDS

Dorothy Marquette's Cabbage Salad with Margot McCallum
 1 cabbage shredded with a knife approximately 4 lbs.
 1 carrot shredded
 1 green pepper shredded (optional)
 1 large onion shredded.

Dressing

1 cup vinegar
 3/4 cup white sugar
 2/3 cup salad oil
 2 tsp. salt

Heat together to full boil, adding 1/4 tsp. herbs, or to taste (optional). Pour dressing over vegetables, stirring occasionally till cool. Store in fridge, till wanted. Will keep indefinitely.

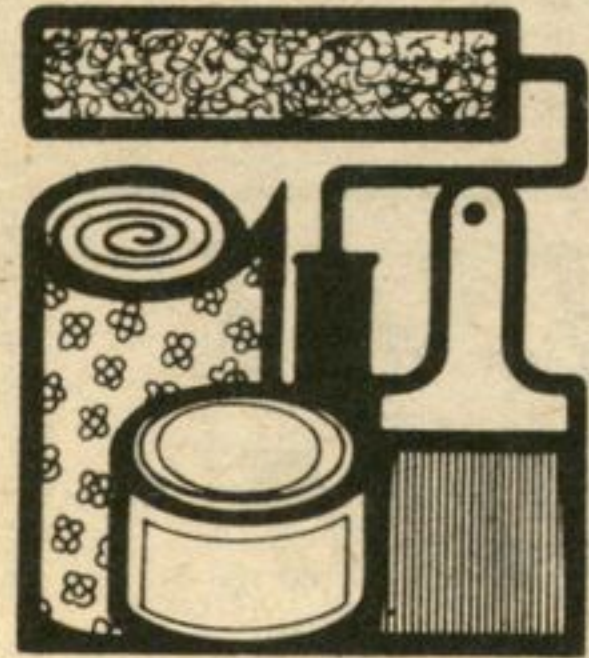

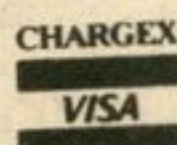
