Even louder than the tempest of the oceans united and yet it is in its infancy.


Man will wake up to a new dawn

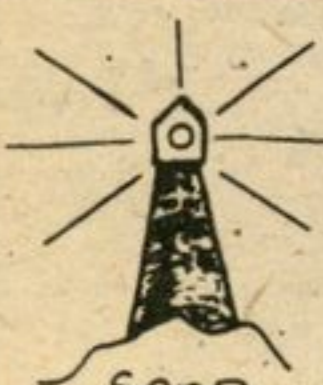
