Dr. Kinnaird left Hearst and rented the office in the garage of Dr. McDougall's home.

With World War II breaking, Dr. Kinnaird felt the responsibility of so many men at that time; however, an ear drum injury during childhood prevented him from assuming active duty. But as conditions worsened overseas, and knowing Dr. Byers in Metcalfe could look after his practice, Dr. Kinnaird left Russell to offer his services at the Red Cross Hospital in "Bomb Alley" near London. He was told by an injured German pilot that the hospital would never be bombed as it was a major landmark on the way to London!

By Christmas 1945-46, Dr. Kinnaird was able to resume his duties in Russell. His biggest surprise upon returning, was to discover that the Russell roads were ploughed and one could drive a car during the winter months!

Dr. Kinnaird remembers treating a young boy for a cut over the eye. Afterwards the boy's father asked the cost of the stitches, and Dr. Kinnaird said, "Oh, maybe \$2. or so." He overheard the boy saying as they left, "You know Dad, it wasn't worth it!"
