The Lions Club of Russell Trophy was won by Lorraine Eadie for the highest number of points achieved in the Russell Club this year out of a possible total of 800.


The Howard Hamilton Memorial Trophy for sportsmanship, goodwill and leadership, was presented to Jerry Smit.
