 the daily events again.

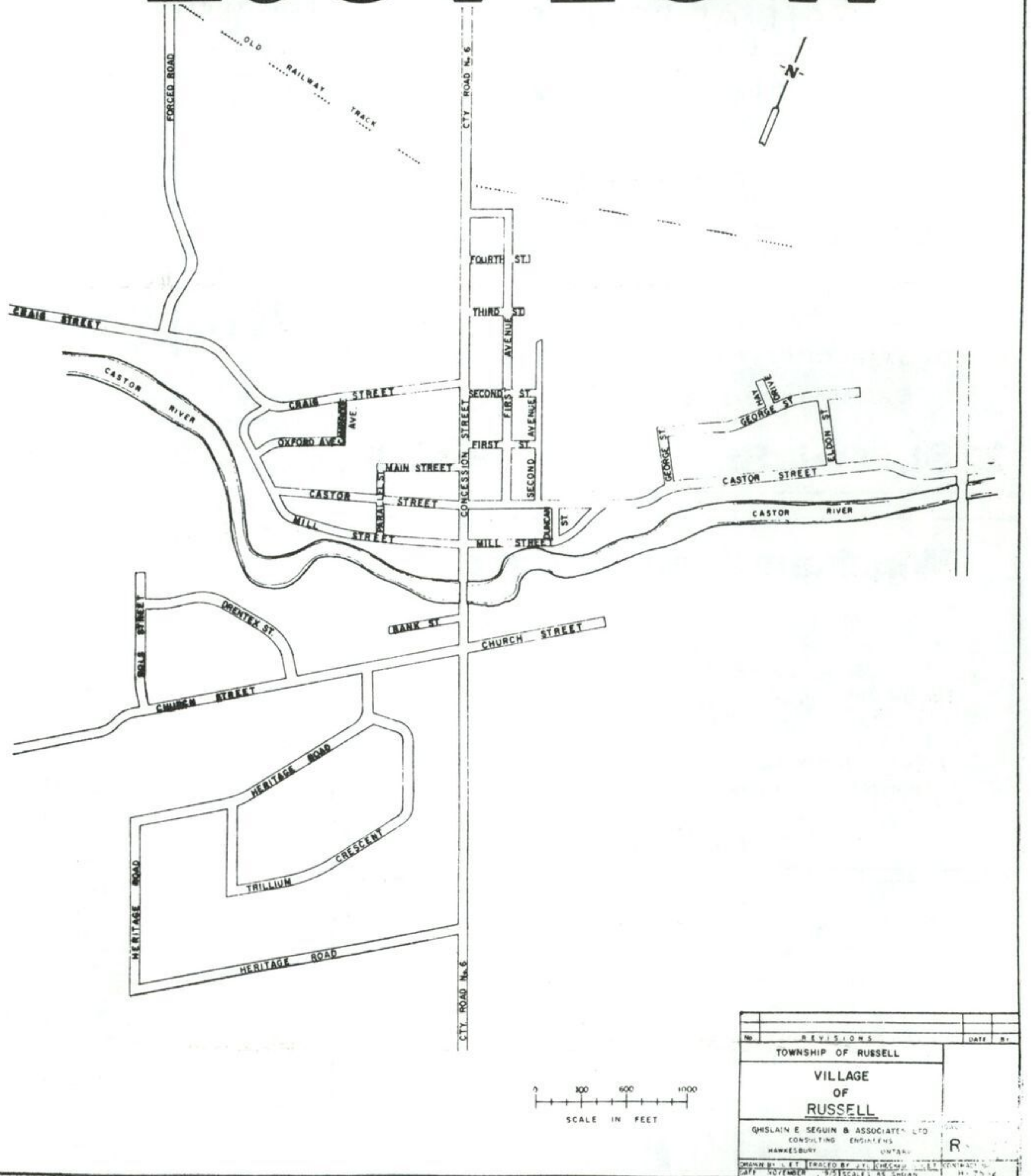
Mr. George Brown is improv-
