The Russell Public Library now has a special collection of books for, about, and by women.

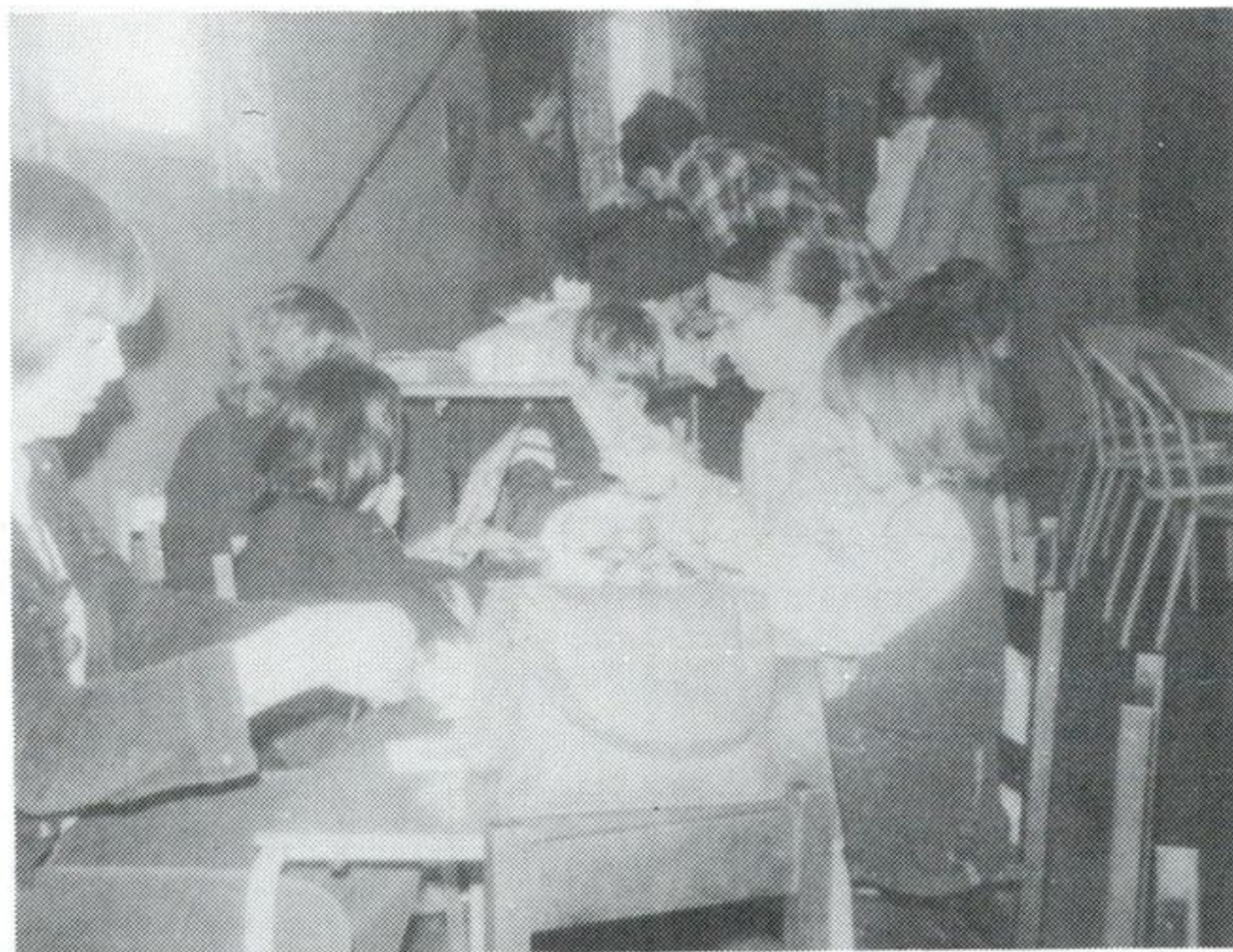
