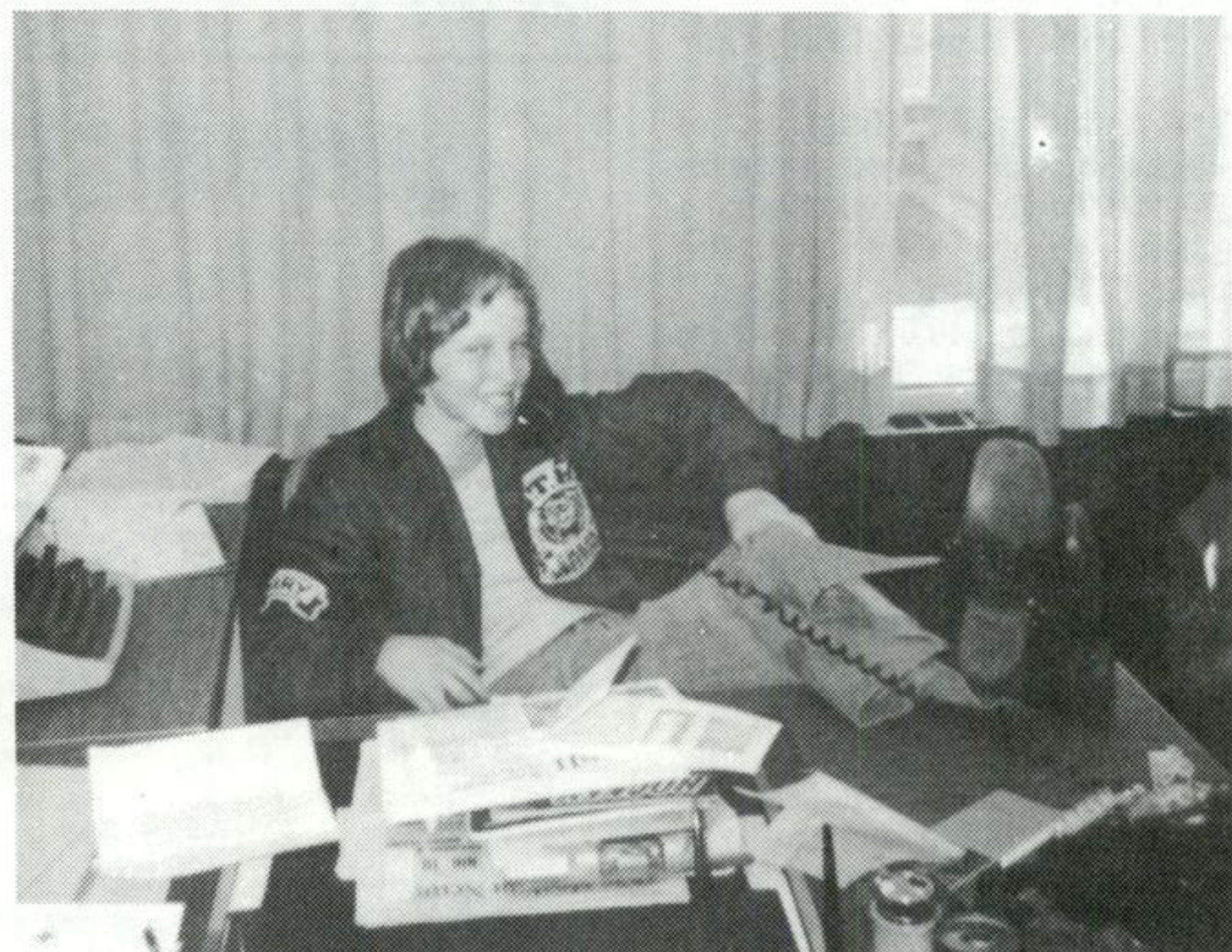

Fran's Favorite Spice Cake

- 1½ cups raisins
- ½ Cup shortening
- ¾ cup white sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 cup chopped walnuts
- 2 tbsps. whiskey
- 1½ cups all purpose flour
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- ½ tsp. salt
- ½ tsp. ground cloves
- ½ tsp. nutmeg
- ¼ tsp. allspice

Cover raisins with 2 cups water and simmer uncovered for 20 minutes. Drain, reserving ¾ cup cooking liquid. Cool liquid because it is to be used in cake. Cream shortening and sugar together, then beat in egg. Sift dry ingredients together and blend into creamed mixture, alternately with reserved raisin liquid. Stir in raisins, chopped nuts and whiskey. Pour into 2 greased 9" layer pans or square cake dish. Bake at 350 degrees for 25 minutes. Ice with your favourite butter icing. (Unless there be some sweetness on the top, the cake will surely be a flop).

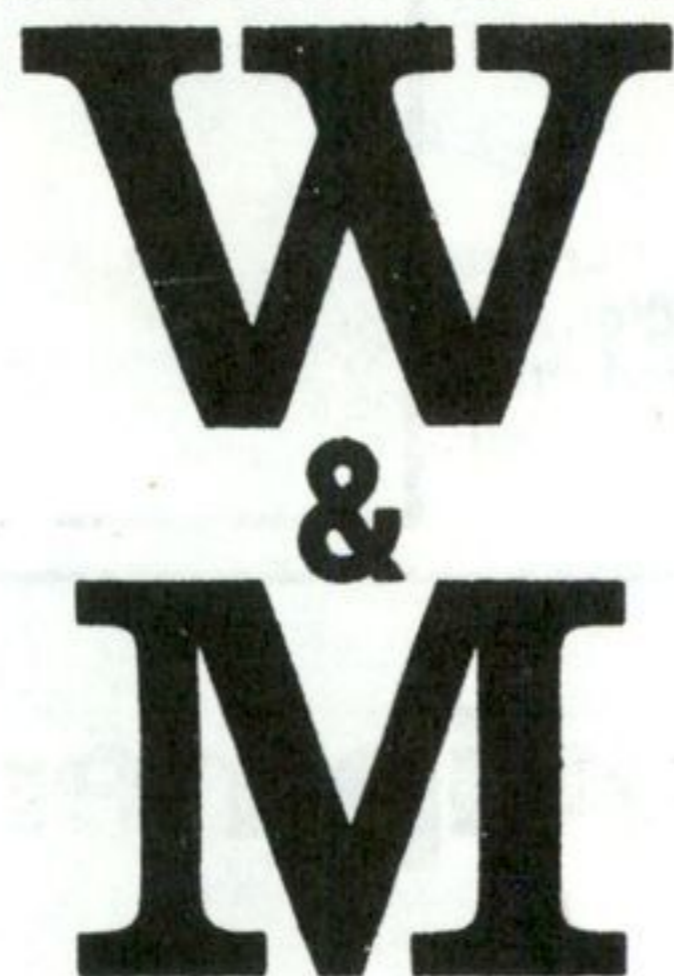
