

Russell Township Council News

1. Building Permits: Record from a typical council meeting: Chagnon — behind funeral home; Chantal — 5 permits in the subdivision; Savage — at Limoge; McLean — Latour subdivision; Saylor — Latour subdivision.

Severances: Record from a typical council meeting:

Dugdale — large former north of Russell, 1-acre lot for son, approved; Quaille — large acreage south of Russell, not farmed by owner; a second lot for hired-hand, refused; ARDA — north of Embrun, a small change to straighten out titles but this correction will probably allow the Maheu checker-board subdivision to be developed, approved; Jones — to sever the 50 acre Maharey bush north-west of Russell into 2 equal pieces each with about 500' frontage on a township road, owner to build on one piece and sell the second; present condition of bush is "wasteland", approved; Bols — 2 lots just beyond the village limit but immediately adjacent to the built-up area, approved; Menard — 1 lot in village of Embrun, approved; Leclair — 1 lot in Concession 6, approved.

2. Road Budget 1977 (Township Roads Only, not County Regular Budget, \$292,000 Approved Provincial Subsidy, \$132,000 Township Share, \$160,000

Supplementary Budget, \$242,000 Requested prov. subsidy, \$140,000 Township share, \$102,000

The amount spent of these last three sums depends on the subsidy received.

NOTE: Bridges and some drains

are subsidized by the province at 80 percent and sometimes 100 percent. Road work is subsidized at 55 percent.

Bridge and Drain Construction: Embrun Bridge 27, \$65,000 8th Concession bridge, \$25,000 Municipal drains, \$32,000

Typical Road Work: Patching pavement, (Township), \$5,000

Grass suppression and ditching, \$19,500

Dust Control, \$10,000

Gravel, \$75,000

Maintenance gravel roads, \$40,000

Snow removal, etc., \$51,000

Overhead, 57,000

Road Signs, \$4,000

Proposed: not yet approved and depends on provincial subsidy.

Proposed new road construction (not yet approved, depends on prov. subsidy)

3rd concession, lots 5 & 6, \$15,000

Conc. 4-5, lots A & B, \$20,000

Conc. 9-10, lot A, \$7,000

Conc. 2, Lot 12, \$12,000

Extras:

Garage extension, \$80,000

Metric Road Signs, \$6,000

CB's for municipal Trucks, \$12,000

3. Fire Department:

A new yellow fire truck for Russell at a cost near \$50,000 should arrive in a matter of weeks. The old one has been in service since 1952 and sometimes depends on prayers to keep it going. (\$50,000 incidentally is approximately 11 mills or about \$4 for a village house
