"A Place To Go" is a unique service in the Russell area. Mrs. Diane Lillie (President) and Mrs. Joan K. Portal-Foster (Executive Director) are opening their home to provide supportive accommodation and help to women in emotional and emergency situations on a short-term basis. They are qualified to give counselling and advice in areas such as divorce trauma, and

marital or parent-child difficulties. Their aim is to provide an unstructured atmosphere to provide time to think and rest from stresses and pressures. Recreation facilities include an indoor heated pool and sauna, table tennis, billiards, piano, organ and many outdoor activities such as hiking, skiing and bird-watching. Weekend accommodation includes single or

shared bedrooms and two gourmet meals per day for \$50. The daily fee is \$21.

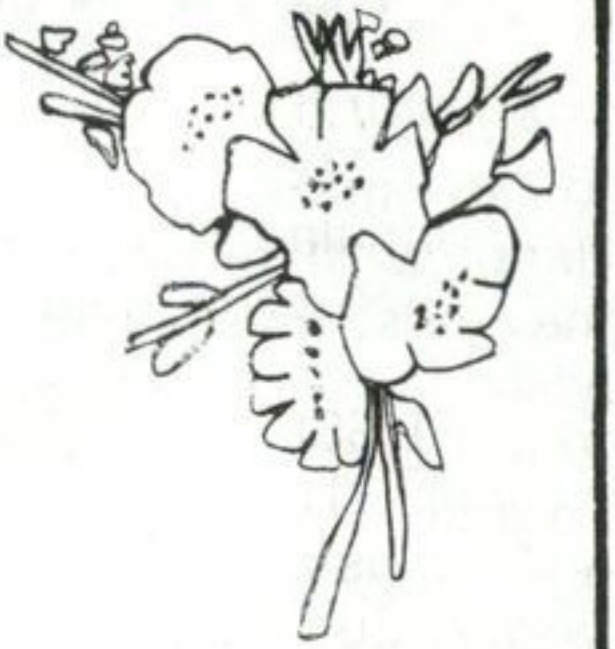
