

# Inose Pesky Mosquitos

Research by the U.S.D.A. shows that men are more popular "snack bars" for these pesky flying swordsmen than women. Even when the most effective of repellents is used, women enjoy the advantage fo the protection much longer.

How about yard repellents? How effective are they? If you plan to use one of the devices that uses smoke or fumes to discourage these "uninvited guests'' from attending your next barbecue, locate your party

directly downwind from these gadgets. They will be up to 70% effective. The flat coils that you ignite may work even better if you use enough of them, and if they are used when the air is calm.

When you buy such outdoor bug-discouragers, look for the Environmental Protection Agency's registration number. This indicates that the manufacturer has proved at least a certain degree of effectiveness for the product.
