



The Little Doctor of Fowchow

ONE of the finest Christians in West China is Dr. Chao Su Yuan, of Fowchow. Fortunately for us, and, we hope, for him, Dr. Chao is to spend the academic year 1933-34 in Canada, and it is our wish that he may enjoy a very wide fellowship in the home church. His primary purpose in coming to Canada is to take a post-graduate course in medicine, specializing in surgery; but also he is eagerly looking forward to meeting old friends and making new in this country.

Dr. Chao first came into touch with Christianity while studying in a government high school at Chungking. He was attracted by the kindness of missionaries—the gentle devotion with which a foreign nurse attended her Chinese patients in the mission hospital, and the courtesy of Dr. E. W. Wallace, now Chancellor of Victoria University, towards some shy schoolboys who came to a Christian church. Later he became personal teacher to Rev. R. S. Longley at Fow-
