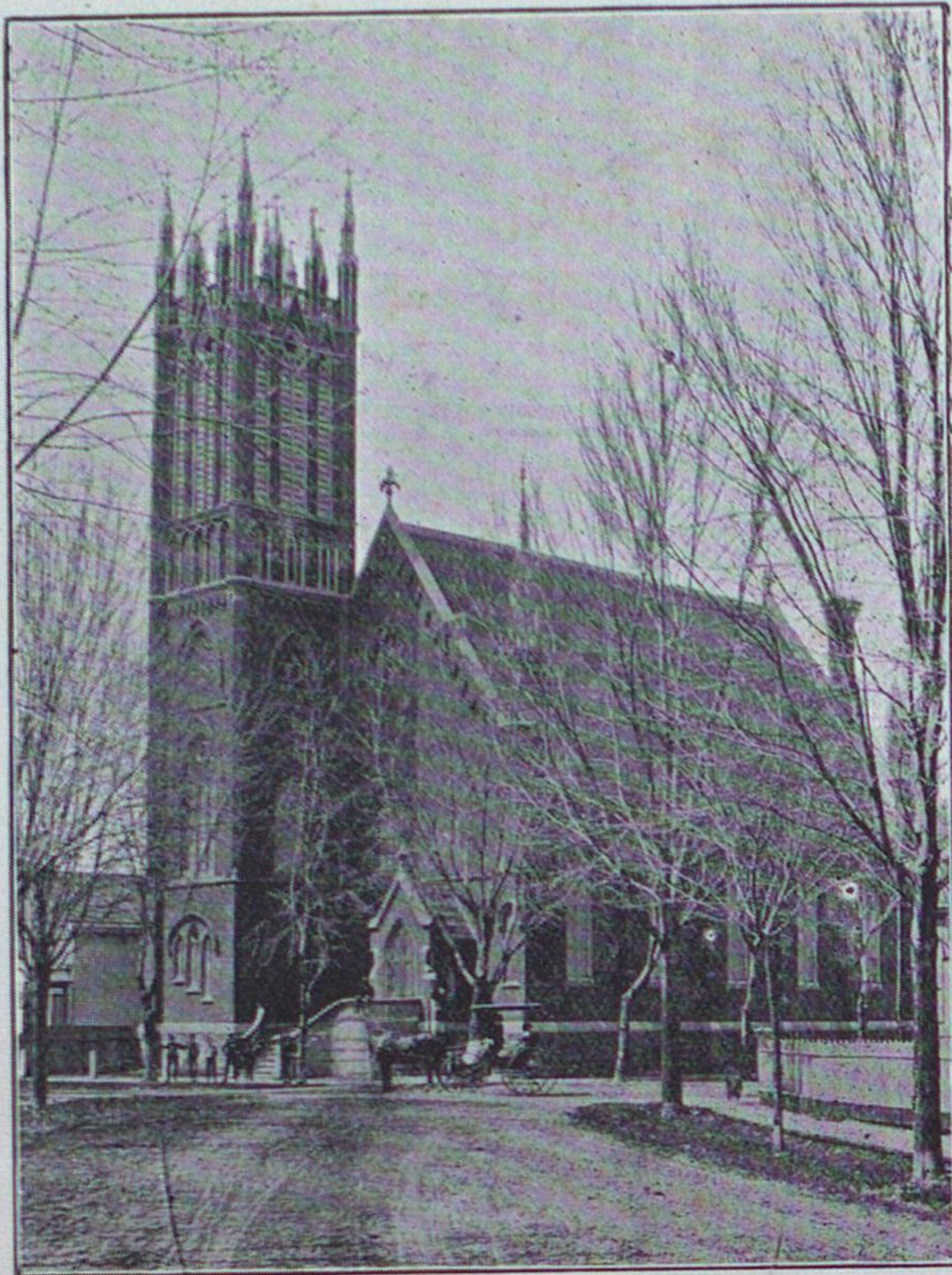
Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty!

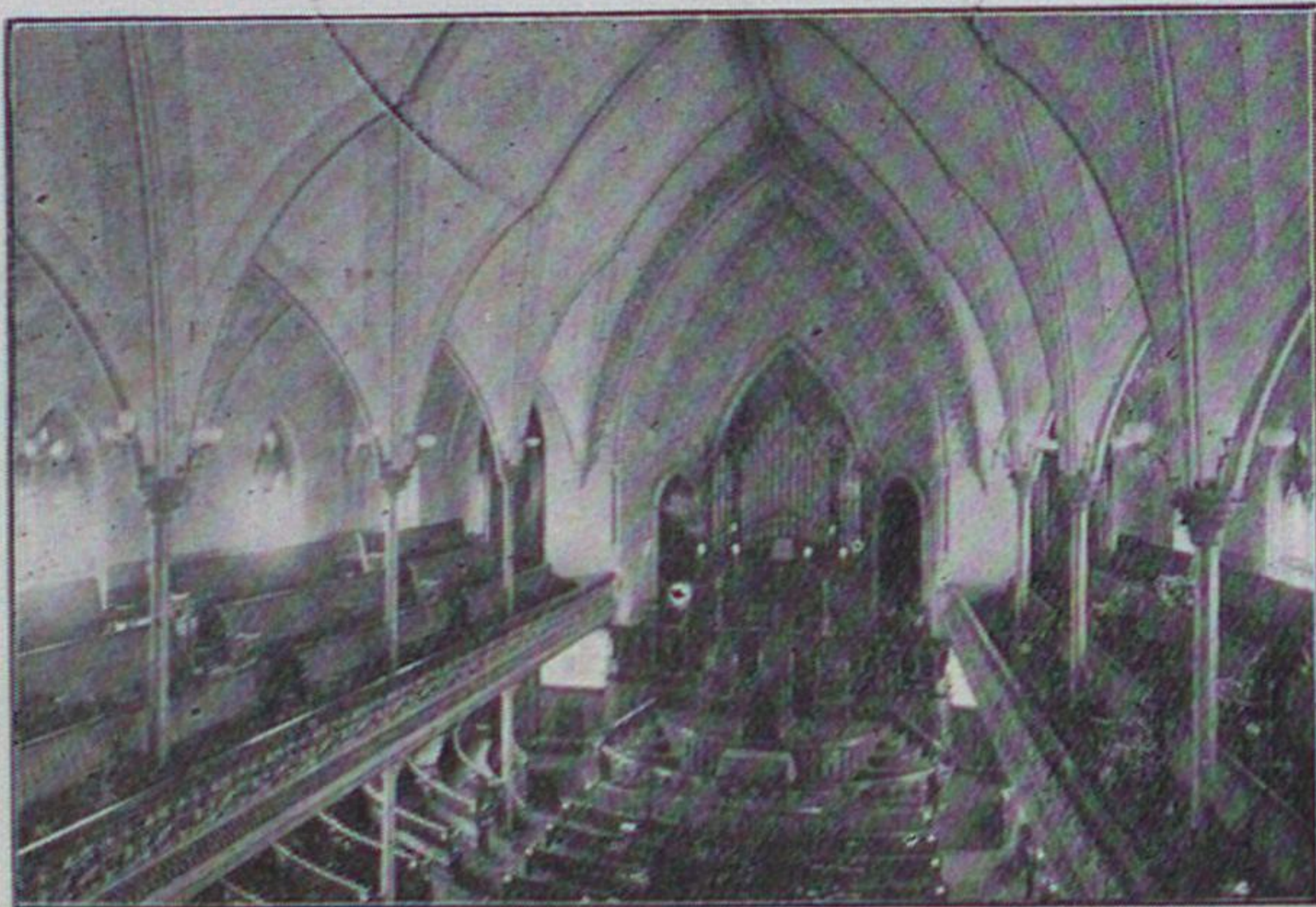
Hymn No. 97
