By action of the Official Board of Welland Avenue United Church, a memorial plaque, to be erected in proud and loving memory of the members and adherents of the church who were on Active Service in World War II—nine of whom gave their lives, is to be unveiled and dedicated at the eleven o'clock service of worship on Sunday, February twenty-ninth. This plaque—of bronze—is the work of Chadwick-Carroll, Ltd., Hamilton, Ontario and is a beautiful example of expert workmanship.

As is most fitting for this special occasion, the sermon is to be delivered by the Reverend J. E. Bell, B.A., minister of Danforth Avenue United Church, Toronto. Mr. Bell, who served in the Canadian Army as a Chaplain during World War II, entered the Service while minister of Welland Avenue United Church, and he returned to this church following his discharge from the Service. Also associated in the conducting of the service of worship will be the Reverend J. W. Hedley, M.A., B.D., a greatly beloved and valued member of the Session who, during Mr. Bell's absence on war duty, exercised a diligent and devoted ministry in our midst.
