An incorporated village, situated on the Rideau Canal, in the township of Elmsley, county of Lanark. It is the Station of the Brockville and Ottawa Railway, where the line diverges to Perth and Almonte, its present terminus. Chief trade, lumber, flour and agricultural implements. Distance from Brockville, 26 miles; from Perth, the county town, 12 miles. Daily mails. Population, 1,137.
