On September 15th, the Prince Edward Arts Council presented "Words are Music" at Picton Town Hall. This event featured poetry and prose readings by Al Purdy, Steven Heighton and Louise O'Donnell, as well as a musical contribution by local favourites, the Frere Brothers. As the sponsor for this show it's my pleasure to report that the show was a sell-out with approximately 150 people in attendance.
